Wednesday May 19 1875

comes in with fresh breeze from N. E. with heavy swell blowing to the S. W. middle and latter part the same winds

Tall 30.50 ft

Thursday May 20 1875

comes in with strong breeze from the N. E. and squally and heavy rain middle part the same latter part more moderate winds

Friday May 21 1875

comes in with calm middle and latter part the same so ends

Saturday June 1st 1875

comes in with light air and calm with light rain middle and latter part the same so ends

Tall 31.50 ft

Sunday June 2d 1875

comes in with moderate breeze from the S. E. with fine weather steering W. under short sail middle part the same at 5 P.M. have two hauls of S. E. W. latter part fine so ends

Tall 31.43 ft Tare 49.11 lb

Monday June 3d 1875

comes in with moderate breeze from the S. E. steering S. W. without the new forecast and lost the old one and the old fore so ends Tall 31.30 ft Tare 50.06 lb

Tuesday June 4th 1875

comes in with a light breeze from the S. E. and fine weather middle part the same employed hauling down latter part wind and weather the same so ends

Tall 30.50 ft Tare 51.07 lb

Wednesday June 5th 1875

comes in with moderate breeze from the S. E. steering W. employed towing rigging middle and latter part the same so ends

Tall 31.16 ft Tare 52.50 lb

Thursday June 6 1875

comes in with fresh breeze from the S. E. middle and latter part the same so ends

Tall 30.07 ft Tare 53.07 lb

Friday June 7 1875

comes in with moderate breeze from the S. E. middle and latter part the same so ends

Tall 29.47 ft Tare 52.19 lb

Saturday June 8 1875

comes in with moderate breeze from the S. E. middle and latter part wind and weather the same so ends

Tall 29.50 ft
