

Remarks on Board wh Clara L. Sparks

Thursday June 20 1878

comes in with light air from the SSW
and fine weather middle and latter
part the same so ends

Friday June 21 1878

comes in with light air from the
S and fine weather employed at
various jobs middle and latter
part the same so ends spoke wh Edward Lee
and Big Bird Small

Lat 31.40 N Lon 49.20 W

Saturday June 22 1878

comes in with moderate breeze from the
SW and fine weather Big Bird Small
and Edward Lee in sight to be used employed
painting the boats get a stern Boat of the
Bird Small the water alive with fish
middle part and the same latter part squally
so ends Lat 31.20 N Lon 49.32 W

Sunday June 23 1878

comes in with moderate breeze from the WSW
with light rain squally Bird Small and wh Edward Lee
in sight to be used middle part weather the same
latter part same so ends

Lat 31.15 N Lon 49.32 W

Monday June 24 1878

comes in with a moderate breeze from the NE
and fine weather middle part light air employed
various jobs put the Starboard Boat over the stern and
put the Boat we got from the Bird Small on the Starboard
cranes latter part fine so ends

Lat 31.59 N Lon 48.14 W

Remarks on Board wh Clara L. Sparks

Tuesday June 25 1878

comes in with moderate breeze from the
NW and fine weather middle part
the same spoke the schooner Jago Phillips
90 sperm latter part fine so ends

Lat 31.35 N Lon 48.31 W

Wednesday June 26 1878

comes in with light breeze from the
E and fine weather saw 3 vessels
showed down the beach of it we had on
deck from the last whale middle and
latter part wind and weather the same
so ends this day

Lat 31.41 N Lon 49.05

Thursday June 27 1878

comes in with light air from the ENE
middle and latter part the same
so ends this day

Lat 32.05 N Lon 49.25 W

Friday June 28 1878

comes in with light air and calm with
rain a Bark in sight middle part calm
latter part light air from the Eastward
so ends

Saturday June 29 1878

comes in with calm middle and latter
part the same 2 sail in sight so ends
this day

Lat 32.10 N Lon 50.16 W
