Wednesday July 10 1878

comes in with moderate breeze from the
E. with light rain squalls middle part
the same latter part clear so ends

Lat 31.00 N Lon 51.17 W

Thursday July 11 1878

comes in with moderate breeze from the
E. heading to the E. with middle part the same
at 4 P.M. saw sperm whale several struck one
got him alongside at dark there whales were
going to the E. W. latter part fine so ends

Lat 31.30 N Lon 51.00 W

S.B. 3516

Friday July 12 1878

comes in with light breeze from the E.
at day light commenced cutting at day light
finished at noon and started the work
middle and latter part fine so ends
the barometer still in sight so ends

Lat 29.31 Lon 51.43 W

Saturday July 13 1878

comes in with light air from the eastward
middle part the same when a heavy fog
to the westward latter part weather fine

Lat 31.08 N Lon 51.43 W

Sunday July 14 1878

comes in with light air from the eastward employed stowing
down stowed down part of the oil and worked the decks
finished at noon middle and latter part the same so ends

Lat 31.17

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Monday July 15 1878

comes in with light air from the eastward
middle part the same employed stowing down
at latter part the same very warm day so ends

Lat 31.17 Lon 51.08 W

Tuesday July 16 1878

comes in with light breeze from the eastward
and fine weather middle part the same latter
part fine so ends

Lat 31.15 N Lon 50.51 W

Wednesday July 17 1878

comes in with light air from the eastward
and fine weather middle part the same latter
part calm so ends

Lat 31.40 N Lon 50.20 W

Thursday July 18 1878

comes in with moderate breeze from the eastward
middle part squally wind hauled to the westward
latter part rainy so ends

Lat 31.49

Friday July 19 1878

comes in with westerly wind and squally
middle and latter part the same so ends

Lat 31.51 N Lon 48.55 W
