Saturday July 20 1878

comes in with westerly wind and fine weather middle part spoke wh. Charles Thompson latter part the same so ends

Lat 31 48.01' Long 45 00.00'

Sunday July 21 1878

comes in with moderate breeze from the Westward and fine weather middle part light shower of rain the Charles Thompson in sight latter part the same so ends this day

Lat 31.15.11' Long 45.12.11'

Monday July 22 1878

comes in with light breeze from the westward middle part calm a whaler in sight latter part calm so ends spoke the Charles Thompson 5 mouth out 90 sperm

Lat 31.35.01' Long 45.13.11'

Tuesday July 23 1878

comes in with calm middle part the same very warm a whaling returner in sight latter part calm so ends

Lat 31.42.11' Long 45.25.11'

Wednesday July 24 1878

comes in with light breeze from the SE and fine weather middle part the same passed a shark with a harpoon and two fathoms of small line fast to him latter part moderate so ends

passed the shark with a harpoon in him Lat 31.40 Long 45.25

Thursday July 25 1878

comes in with light breeze from the SE and fine weather middle and latter part the same so ends

Lat 31.39.11' Long 45.19.11'

Friday July 26 1878

comes in with a light breeze from the eastward with fine weather middle part the same spoke the wh. Carrie L. Clark Capt Marshall 240 sperm latter part fine so ends

Lat 31.40 Long 45.39

Saturday July 27 1878

comes in with a light breeze from the eastward and fine with a few light showers of rain middle part the same in company with wh. Carrie Clark latter part the same so ends

Lat 31.20 Long 45.00

Sunday July 28 1878

comes in with light air from the eastward with fine weather middle and latter part the same so ends

Lat 31.04 Long 45.02.11'

Monday July 29 1878

comes in with moderate breeze from the eastward and fine weather middle and latter part the same so ends

Lat 31.39.11' Long 45.13.11'
