15 bbls schooner Helen all dimensions  
and Carrie Clark sent 18 barrels of  
casks on board the Phillips for one part  
of the whate at 3 1/2 finished loading  
middle and latter part moderate  
se ends

Friday Aug 7 1875

comes in with light air from the NW  
and fine weather employed stowing  
down went on board the Phillips and  
get out and stowed it alongside  
15 barrels middle and latter part  
fine winds this day

Saturday Aug 10 1875

comes in with light air from the westward  
and fine weather employed stowing down at noon  
finished and washed down middle part fine  
rascal men haulmen in sight latter part  
fine se ends

comes in with light air from the westward and  
fine weather middle and latter part the same  
two whalers in sight se ends

Tuesday Aug 13 1875

comes in with light air and calm middle

loaded with grain latter part calm  
se ends

Lat 32.30 cl' Lon 84.43 W'

Wednesday Aug 14 1875

comes in with light air from the eastward  
middle part moderate breeze latter part  
the same se ends

Lat 32.40 Lon 84.30

Thursday Aug 15 1875

comes in with light air from the eastward  
and very warm middle and latter part  
the same se ends

Lat 33.05 cl' Lon 84.34

Friday Aug 16 1875

comes in with a moderate breeze from the  
eastward and fine weather middle and latter  
part the same se ends

Lat 33.20 cl' Lon 83.23 W'
