

Remarked Brantish Clara Le Sparks

Thursday Sept 19 1875

comes in with a light air from the
S and fine weather and calms at 5 o'clock
Saw about 3 boats and commenced
towing for the harbor at noon took
the boat up with a light breeze from
the E and commenced towing for the
harbor about 5 miles off middle part
middle part latter part the same so ends

Friday Sept 20 1875

comes in with a light breeze from the
SE and fine weather middle part the
same at 4 o'clock came to anchor in
St Michael so on all hands employed
towing the vessel taking the boat
ashore unloading sails and so on
latter part fine so ends

Saturday Sept 21 1875

Lying at anchor in St Michael
comes in with light easterly wind and
fine weather all hands employed at
various jobs middle part the same
the schooner Phillips came and the Port William
so ends

Sunday Sept 22 1875

comes in with an easterly wind and fine
weather middle and latter part the same
so ends at anchor in St Michael

Monday Sept 23 1875

Lying in St Michael employed at
harbor duty so ends

Tuesday Sept 24 1875

Lying at St Michael come employed at
at various jobs so ends

Wednesday Sept 25 1875

Lying at anchor in St Michael
employed at filling water firing, haul
gear and other jobs 4 men have
left the vessel Pat Hem and Tom Gray
and Harry, Pat and Tom Gray in fact
so ends

Thursday Sept 26 1875

Lying at anchor in St Michael
employed at harbor duty so ends

Friday Sept 27 1875

comes in with westerly wind and fine weather
middle part the same latter part rainy so on
all hands employed various jobs so ends

Saturday Sept 28 1875

Lying at anchor in St Michael westerly wind
and good weather all hands variously employed
so ends

Sunday Sept 29 1875

Lying at St Michael employed at
harbor duty so ends
