fine weather employed at watering painting  
and other jobs so on

Wednesday Oct 9 1878

fine weather sailing at St Michael's  
employed watering painting and other  
jobs received two cuds of wood so on

Thursday Oct 10 1878

Sailing at St Michael's

employed taking in wood and stowing the hold  
so on

Friday Oct 11 1878

Sailing at St Michael's

employed taking in wood and stowing the hold  
so on

Saturday Oct 12 1878

Sailing at St Michael's employed bending sails  
stowing away wood and so on
