Sunday Oct 13 1848

Lying at St Michaels, fine weather

Monday Oct 14 1848

Lying at St Michaels employed
employed painting inside fine weather
nine men have run away up to the date
two of them in the latrine Salt and Tom Gray
so ends

Tuesday Oct 15 1848

Lying at St Michaels employed
getting ready for sea ready

Wednesday Oct 16 1848

Lying at St Michaels employed
getting ready for sea received 70 bushels of
Sweet potatoes and 30 bushels of Irish
potatoes, curing pumpkins and so on

Thursday Oct 17 1848

Lying at St Michaels at noon left our
merrings and hauled out to the buoy
and anchored employed taking care of
boat and other job another man run away
John Heale this makes runaways two runaways
came on board in irons Pat and Tom Gray
so ends

Friday Oct 18 1848

at one P.M. got underway and shot out
and lay off and on waiting for men so on
strong report from the Westward at 3 P.M. came
to anchor again so ends

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Saturday Oct 19 1848

Laying off and on Blowing strong
from the N.W. at 2 P.M. came to anchor
off the Breakwater so on waiting for men
Captain ashore so on tying of anchor with
Shot and anchor and 40 fathoms of chain
so on waiting for men

Sunday Oct 20 1848

came in with a strong breeze from the N.W.
at 4 P.M. got underway and shot to sea
all hands on board middle part strong
breeze steering S.W. until the Pursuit and
brought out the job still days in sight
employed at steering anchor and chains
latter part the same so ends

Monday Oct 21 1848

came in with a strong breeze from the N.W.
steering S.W. middle part more moderate
latter part the same so ends

Tuesday Oct 22 1848

came in with a light breeze from the
N.W. steering S.W. dark down weather
middle and latter part the same so ends

Wednesday Oct 23 1848

came in with light air from the N.W.
steering S.W. middle and latter part the same
so ends picked up a barrel of Kiverine
