Friday Dec 29 1878

came in with fresh trade employed looking
middle part calm at 4 till finished looking latter
part more moderate so ends the day

Saturday Dec 30 1878

came in with heavy trade with rough sea
went under forward topmast and Bowed out the fore
employed showing down middle and latter
part rough weather so ends the day

Sunday Dec 31 1878

came in with a strong breeze from the N E
with heavy swell middle part the same
hunting to the N E at 4 till noon ship
latter part the same so ends the day

Monday Dec 1st 1879

came in with a fresh breeze from the N E
prevailing to the Eastward middle and
latter part wind and weather the same
so ends the day

Tuesday Dec 3 1878

came in with a moderate breeze from
the N E and fine weather middle and
latter part the same so ends

Wednesday Dec 4 1878

came in with a fresh breeze from the N E
middle part light rain squalls with heavy
swell latter part the same so ends

Leaft 1825 S Len 33.10 W

Thursday Dec 5 1878

came in with fresh trade and
fine weather steering S by W middle
and latter part more moderate
with heavy swell so ends

Leaft 1943 S Len 34.33 W

Friday Dec 6 1878

came in with a moderate breeze from the
N E and fine weather steering S by W middle
part the same employed looking out
provisions save Blackfish and Salted
biscuit but got nothing latter part fine
so ends the day

Leaft 2046 S Len 33.41 W

Saturday Dec 7 1878

came in with a strong breeze from the N E
steering S by W middle and latter part
heavy swell from the S W so ends

Leaft 2256 S Len 33.53 W
