

Remarks on Board ship Clara de Sparks

Sunday Dec 8 1838

comes in with a strong breeze from the SE
steering S.W. under foresail & mizzen
middle part the same latter part the same
at dark here to on the Starboard tack
so ends this day

Lat 24 57 S Lon 34 24 W

Monday Dec 9 1838

comes in with a strong breeze from the
SE and rough weather middle part
more moderate with some rain
latter part moderate wind hauled
to the S.W. and

Lat 25 49 S Lon

Tuesday Dec 10 1838

comes in with a strong breeze from the
South heavy mist middle part the same
latter part more moderate with rain
so ends

Lat 25 50 S Lon 35 49 W

Wednesday Dec 11 1838

comes in with a moderate breeze from
the eastward a cloudy weather middle
part the same steering W. latter part
the same so ends this day

caught a porpoise

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Thursday Dec 12 1838

comes in with a light breeze from the SE
with rain middle and latter part variable
winds with constant rain so ends

Friday Dec 13 1838

comes in with strong breeze from the
SE and rainy weather middle part
the same very stormy weather latter
part the same so ends this day

Lat 25 53 S Lon 37 17 W

Saturday Dec 14 1838

comes in with a light breeze from the
SE and thick cloudy weather middle
and latter part the same so ends

Lat 25 39 S Lon 37 00 W

Sunday Dec 15 1838

comes in with light air and calm
with rain middle part the same
speaks the German Brig latter 6 or
days from St. Petersburg bound to St. Petersburg
so in latter part calm and rain
so ends this day

Monday Dec 16 1838

comes in with light air from the Eastward
and calm and fine weather middle and
latter part the same so ends this day

Lat 25 36 S Lon 36 26 W
