

Remark on Brant see Clara Is. Spack

Friday Jan 10 1879

comes in with a moderate breeze from the East and fine weather middle part the same at 11 o'clock saw sperm whales got into them with the vessel lowered anchor and got one got him along side and commenced cutting out till dark and lashed down and let him hang till morning did not get the head off so on latter part fine so ends

Lat 17° 45' S Lon 34° 35' W

Saturday Jan 11 1879



comes in with a fresh breeze from the N.E. middle part the same commenced cutting and finished at 9 o'clock and started the works 9 o'clock so on latter part moderate so ends

Lat 17° 13' S Lon 34° 51' W

Sunday Jan 12 1879

comes in with a fresh breeze from the N.E. middle part squally employed at stowing down latter part the same so ends

Lat 17° 56' S Lon 34° 48' W

Monday Jan 13 1879

comes in with a light breeze from the N.E. and fine weather middle and latter part the same so ends

Lat 18° 10' S Lon 34° 24' W

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Tuesday Jan 14 1879

comes in with a strong breeze from the N.E. and squally middle part strong breeze latter part more moderate so ends

Wednesday Jan 15 1879

comes in with a moderate breeze from the N.E. and fine weather middle part the same latter part fine so ends

Lat 17° 54' S Lon 34° 24' W

Thursday Jan 16 1879

comes in with a light breeze from the N.E. and fine weather middle part the same passed a full rigged Brig latter part fine so ends

Lat 17° 35' S Lon 33° 50' W

Friday Jan 17 1879

comes in with a light breeze from the N.E. and fine weather middle part calm latter part the same so ends

Lat 17° 41' S Lon 33° 48' W

Saturday Jan 18 1879

comes in with fresh breeze from the East and squally middle part the same latter part more moderate so ends

Lat 17° 04' S Lon 33° 30' W
