Wednesday Jan 29 1849

comes in with fresh trades and squally
middle part the same steering to the Westward
latter part fresh breeze so ends

Lat 41° S Lon 31° 50' W

Thursday Jan 30 1849

comes in with moderate trades and fine
weather middle part the same steering
to the Westward latter part fine
so ends

Lat 41° 13' S Lon 32° 30' W

Friday Jan 31 1849

comes in with strong trades middle
and latter part the same steering to
the ESE so ends this day

Lat 41° 04' S Lon 32° 44' W

Saturday Feb 1st 1849

comes in with strong trades steering E
middle and latter part strong breeze
so ends

Lat 40° 09' S Lon 33° 32' W

Sunday Feb 2d 1849

comes in with strong trades steering
ESE middle and latter part the same
so ends

Lat 39° 47' S Lon 34° 20' W

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Monday Feb 3d 1849

comes in with fresh trades middle part the
same steering ESE latter part more
moderate with rain squally so ends

Lat 42° 41' S Lon 3

Tuesday Feb 4th 1849

comes in with a light breeze from the
ESE and moderate weather steering
ESE middle part the same same
Blackbird and two of old net strike
water disclosed latter part moderate
so ends

Lat 43° 01' S Lon 34° 50' W

Wednesday Feb 5 1849

comes in with a moderate breeze from
the E and cloudy weather with light
rain squally middle part fresh breeze
latter part the same steering ESE
so ends

Lat 44° 01' S Lon 35° 40'

Thursday Feb 6 1849

comes in with a strong breeze from the
ESE and squally steering to the E
middle and latter part squally so ends
saw a pack of tigers steering E

Lat 43° 03' S

Friday Feb 7 1849

comes in with a strong breeze from the ESE
and squally middle and latter part the same
so ends
