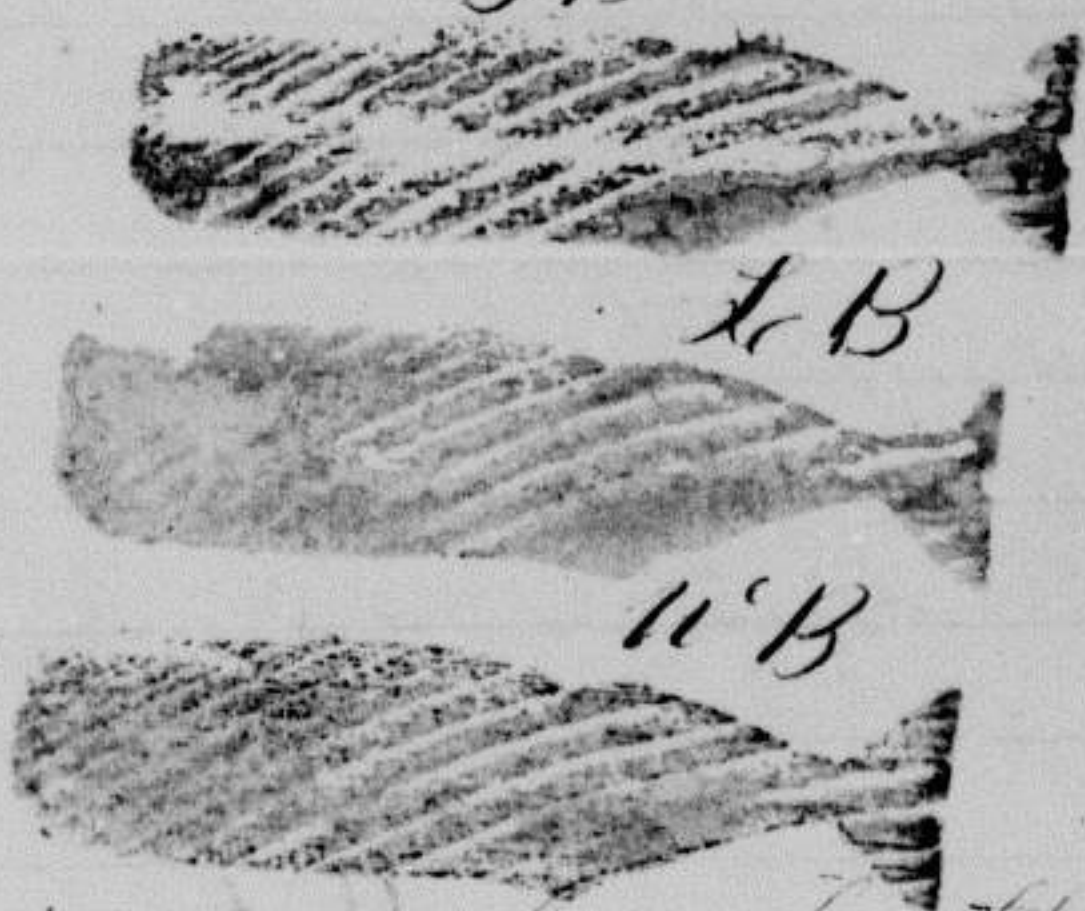


Remarks on Board the Clara & Sparks

Wednesday March 12 1849

comes in with fine weather
at daylight commenced
cutting finished at 9 o'clock
at noon started the work
soon latter part fine
se ends

comes in with moderate trades and fine
weather employed boiling middle part
the same at 4 o'clock finished boiling latter
part fine se ends

weather middle part the same employed at
slowing down latter part fine se ends

Leath 11151' Lon 4234 W

Saturday March 15 1849

comes in with fine weather middle part
the same employed repairing the vessel
Boat stove by a whale latter part fine
se ends Leath 11311' Lon 4235 W

Sunday March 16 1849

comes in with moderate trades and
fine weather middle and latter
part the same se ends

Leath 12031' Lon 4241 W

Monday March 17 1849
comes in with strong trades and
rough weather middle and latter
part the same se ends

Leath 11591' Lon 4249 W

Tuesday March 18 1849
comes in with strong trades and
rough weather crossing under single
sail vessel try sail and jib middle
and latter part cloudy weather
se ends

Leath 12041'

Wednesday March 19 1849

comes in with strong trades and
rough sea middle part the same
at sunset took the vessel out the
try sail latter part strong breeze
Leath 13051' Lon 4312 W

Thursday March 20 1849
comes in with strong trades and squally
weather middle and latter part the same
se ends
