Monday March 31 1849

comes in with strong trades and rough
weather. middle and latter part the same
so ends

Tuesday April 1 1849

comes in with strong trades and
rough weather middle and latter
part the same so ends this day

Lat 12.09 N Lon 45.52 W

Wednesday April 2 1849

comes in with strong trades middle
part the same steering N. E. latter part
strong breezes so ends

Lat 12.07 N Lon 46.37 W

Thursday April 3 1849

comes in with strong trades middle
part the same steering N. E. latter
part the vessel under single reefed
Bermud Bonnet out the top sail and
Bermud out the jib so ends

Lat 12.40 N Lon 48.25 W

Friday April 4 1849

comes in with strong trades middle
part the same steering N. E. W
latter part strong breezes so ends

Lat 13.14 N Lon 49.39 W

Saturday April 5 1849

comes in with strong trades and rough
weather middle part the same latter
part strong trades so ends

Lat 13.33 N Lon 50.44 W

Sunday April 6 1849

comes in with strong trades and
heavy swell middle part the same
saw a schooner a whaler steering
to the westward under three sail and
jib seen latter part equally steering
N. E. W

Lat 13.32 N Lon 52.00 W

Monday April 7 1849

comes in with strong trades steering
to the westward middle part the same
saw square rigged vessel to the
eastward steering to westward
latter part the same so ends

Lat 14.16 N Lon 53.50 W

Tuesday April 8 1849

comes in with fresh trades middle
part more moderate at 9 o'clock saw
humpbacks took them for sperm whales
by sight and gave chase for them
the humpbacks and came aboard
so on steering N. E. W a whaling
back in sight this morning so ends
