Wednesday April 22 1849

Lying at Genoa employed
making stern boat trailings are
so ends

Thursday April 23 1849

comes in with fine weather
lying at Genoa. Antonio
debarred at 6 P.M. got underway
and stood out with a light air off the
land so on latter part moderate

Friday April 24 1849

comes in with light air and calm
middle part of Genoa in sight
also 4 vessels latter part moderate
been from the 16 to ends

Saturday April 25 1849

comes in with strong trade and
squally steering W by E middle part
the same period wh. Super Bird
of Simulac latter part squally steering
W under all sail so ends

Sunday April 26 1849

comes in with strong trade and squally
at dark took in the chain sail and set
the by sail heavy sea running took Boats
on the upper crane, middle and latter
more moderate steering W by E so ends

comes in with fresh trade steering W by E
middle and latter part the same so ends

Monday April 28 1849

comes in with fresh trade, middle part
the same. St. George in sight at 4 P.M.
passed Beauty head latter part moderate
so ends this day

Leatt 17.37.1

Tuesday April 29 1849

comes in with moderate trade and
fine weather lying to under the
land at daylight made sail and
stood in at 4 P.M. came to anchor
in San Bay so on employed painting
boats setting up the stay making Beams
and so on

Wednesday April 30 1849

comes in with light air from the Eastward
at daylight got underway and stood out
at 3 P.M. came to anchor so on under
Topsail and jib to repair Bent went
ashore latter part moderate so ends

Thursday May 1 1849

comes in with calm employed repairing
sails middle and latter part calm
so ends

Friday May 2 1849

comes in with light air and calm
at daylight got underway and stood
out so on cruising for sperm whale
at 4 P.M. came to anchor in 5 fathoms
so ends
