Journal Continued

Thursday Oct 9th At daylight left off from the sea
End of the adventure at 8th P.M. the light-
air & calm most of the day. at sunset about 5 miles
from the shore. I laid in light - got up one chain
took in mainsail & flying jib heading off shore

Friday Oct 10th All this day fresh trade made
sail in the morning at 8 A.M. tacked ship &
stood in shore. Saw Porpoises at 4 P.M. came to
Anchor at Puertoventura on Spanish rocks
on foot nothing more worthy of note - so ends this day

Saturday Oct 11th All this day gentle trade
at daylight got underway stood off shore saw finback
at 11th A.M. tacked in shore. at 4 P.M. came to Anchor
nothing more worthy of note - so ends this day

Sunday Oct 12th Lying at Anchor all day. wind
fresh from the N.E. at sunset got underway steering
S.W. by W. under jib & foresail & try sail one Spanish fish
fished found to the westward nothing more worthy of note.

Monday Oct 13th All this day fresh N.E. trades
saw 1 sail in the P.M. saw Blackfish Porpoises &
2 small Boobies. Steering S.W. by W. under jib & foresail & try sail
Latt 26.46 Long 115.25

Tuesday Oct 14th All this day fresh N.E. trades
Porpoises one sail. Steering S.W. by W. under jib & foresail.
Latt 25.12 Long 116.45

Wednesday Oct 15th All this day light air from
N.E. saw Porpoises, refect. fish. hoisted jib & flying jib
stays. Steering S.W. by W. foresail & try sail
Latt 24.07 Long 117.31

Thursday Oct 16th First part of this day light
air from North westerly & better part gentle fresh from N.W.
nothing in sight worthy of note. Steering S.W. by W.
Latt 22.47 Long 118.35

Friday Oct 17th All this day light air from
the S.W. heading N.W. by the wind. nothing
in sight worthy of note - so ends this day
Latt 22.20 Long 118.54

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Saturday Oct 18th All this day light air from
the N.E. flake out for fish & hoists at 1 P.M. hoisted
for Blackfish got nothing at 2 P.M. took up darts. at
sunset took in sail jib & under jib & by sail. M. C. S.

Sunday Oct 19th All this day light air from
the N.E. at 8 P.M. set foresail & saw porpoises
steering S.W. by W. nothing more worthy of note.
Latt 21.54 Long 119.27

Monday Oct 20th All this day light N.E. trades
saw Porpoises nothing more worthy of note. Steering S.W. by W.
with foresail and jib set.

Tuesday Oct 21th All this day gentle N.E. trades
saw Porpoises, gulls, & a can body. Steering S.W. by W.
with fore sail & jib set. nothing more worthy of note.
Latt 19.23 Long 120.15

Wednesday Oct 22th All this day gentle N.E. trades
saw Blackfish did not lower. Steering S.W. by W. with
foresail & jib set. nothing more worthy of note.
Latt 17.55 Long 122.39

Thursday Oct 23th All this day fresh trades at
day light made the Isle of Sal. at 11th A.M. came to
anchor in Medeira Bay. in P.M. Capt. went on
shore. lost one man. 4 portagues from St. Michaels
refect. old fish caught some fish so ends this day.

Friday Oct 24th All this day gentle N.E. trades
at daylight got underway from Sal. Steering
S.W. by W. at 2 P.M. passed the Lesteer Rock. saw
one fish at sunset took in sail at 8 P.M. here we
head to westward under jib & try sail.
Latt 15.48 Long 123.20

Saturday Oct 25th All this day gentle N.E. trades
at daylight made sail & left off S.W. by W. at 1 P.M.
saw two in the harbor of St. fago. would not accept our
Bell of health. kept off S.W. by W. took in mainsail
the Bark Valerius Gibbs lying off and on. saw
one sail saw Porpoises at 11th P.M. saw 2 fowls
so ends this day steering S.W. by S. under jib & foresail & try sail.
