nothing in sight. steering S.W. under 4 lower sails
Lat 4.08 Long 29.10

Friday Nov 14th All this day fresh S.E.
trades steering S.W. saw a masthead ship
to the westward bound South nothing more in sight
Lat 6.05 Long 29.40

Saturday Nov 15th All this day fresh S.E.
trades nothing in sight worthy of note. steering
S.W. so ends this day
Lat 8.26 Long 30.15

Sunday Nov 16th first part of this day gentle
breezes from the Eastward middle & latter part
light air saw 5 sails bound North at 4 P.M.
took in mainsail & flying jib so ends this day
Lat 11.10 Long 31.14

Monday Nov 17th All this day light breezes from
the N.E. saw 3 sails. steering S.W. reefed old jib
nothing more worthy of note in sight heeled mainsail
out to fast hole so ends this day cloudy

reefing topsail broke out each reef 3 sails in sight
nothing more worthy of note so ends this day
Lat 14.28 Long 32.55

Saturday 22nd All this day light air from all
points. 20 sails in sight saw black fin nothing
more worthy of note so ends this day
Lat 18.08 Long 33.54

Sunday 23rd first part of this day light air
from the South Middle & latter part gentle breezes
from S.E. one sail in sight. steering S.W. by W.
Lat 16.08 Long 33.54

Monday Nov 24th All this day gentle breezes from
the N.W. saw one sail nothing more worthy of
note at sunset took in sail by head N.W.
