Saturday Jan 24th All this day gentle breeze from the Eastward saw Porpoises. 2 sails bound S. nothing more worthy of note.

Sunday Jan 25th All this day gentle breeze from the Eastward. fine weather nothing in sight.

Monday Jan 26th First and middle part of this day fresh breeze fine weather saw one sail. latter part light squally steering N.E. and 4 lower sails.

Tuesday Feb 3rd All this day light breezy. winds and squally. saw Blackfish & Porpoises. one sail bound South nothing more worthy of note.

Monday Feb 9th All this day fresh N.E. breeze nothing in sight at 4 PM. took in main sail at 8 PM. put & threw the heavy sea on. so ends this day.

Tuesday Feb 10th All this day fresh N.E. breeze and rough at 7 PM. saw a large sperm whale of middle year in 2 rapid main sail and worked to windward at 8 PM. whale out of sight. left off N.E. saw 2 sails finback & small breeches at sunset took in main sail & rapid for sail.
