Journal Continued

Friday March 5<sup>th</sup> All this day fresh tracks at anchor referring main sail. Nothing in sight. Steady W. S. wind. Got fore sail & top sail for main sail.

Saturday March 6<sup>th</sup> All this day fresh tracks & squally nothing in sight. Steady W. S. wind. Got fore sail & top sail for main sail. Left 13.36 Lat 5.45

Sunday March 7<sup>th</sup> All this day gentle tracks nothing in sight. Steady W. S. wind. Got fore sail & top sail for main sail. Left 13.36 Lat 5.45

Monday March 8<sup>th</sup> First part of this day fresh tracks & squally. at 5 PM made light in Barbados at 10 PM went on shore got letters & letters put. Squally. Lying off & on. Got sail of ship in port. Got on observation found Char 38 miles distant.

Tuesday March 9<sup>th</sup> Lying off and on at Barbados. Capt on shore. Several new vessels & sailed.

Wednesday March 10<sup>th</sup> At 8 AM Capt. came on board. Made sail and kept off for St. Vincent. Steady W. S. at 3 PM made the land at sunset. Took in 2 jibs & main sail off with the end of Bequia at 8. How far off sea end of Bequia.

Thursday March 11<sup>th</sup> All this day fresh tracks at 8 AM spoke Sch. Letter C. back at 10 PM came to anchor at Mirou with L. E. Cook & Dennis Burns of N. B. do ends this day.

Friday March 12<sup>th</sup> at 6 AM left Mirou. spoke the Argyle at 8 AM. on anchor at Surinam. in C. M. B. Curran got up purchase and broke out. broke. Ceased 2 casks & showed them. do ends this day.

Saturday March 13<sup>th</sup> still at anchor fresh tracks at 10 AM spoke out 8 casks. finished. Boasting and moved off at 6 PM. B. Argyle. to Sea. V. N. B. Curran cruising. do ends this day. all well.

March 14 Sunday Lying at anchor. even on shore. came off sail right. do ends this day.

Monday March 15. Lying at anchor all day. bent old fore sail & jib. Broke out flour & fresh tracks nothing in sight.

Tuesday March 16 at daylight got under weigh with fresh tracks at 10 came to anchor at St. Edward Sea at anchor.

Wednesday March 17. got under weigh went round the Island. Saw one whale at 1 PM anchored at Leslie Bay.

Thursday March 18<sup>th</sup> all this day gentle breezes at daylight got under weigh. Saw 3 whales at 10 AM. Leured. Boat struck at about 11 got 4 fish dead. I took got up sit and slightly. Whales fresh got boat up on mist in the town & on church. Left boat in for repairs. do ends this day.

Friday March 19<sup>th</sup> All this day fresh tracks lying at anchor referring boat. nothing in sight. had 2 men Deserted. Shipped on.

Saturday March 20<sup>th</sup> fresh tracks at 6 AM got under weigh. nothing in sight. at 10 came to anchor in co with Mr. O. Lea & Dennis Byrnes.

Sunday March 21<sup>th</sup> fresh tracks lying at anchor.

Monday March 22<sup>nd</sup> at daylight got under weigh. went out to St. Andrew. Saw several. Whales going quick. Spent 12 hours went around the island at 5 PM anchored.

Tuesday March 23<sup>rd</sup> got under weigh. went out to St. Andrew. at 8 PM. Leured. started to far off at 1 PM. dropped upon our lines got nothing at 3 PM anchored. with Lee.
