Boiling anchored at town

Saturday March 27th out cruising got nothing
anchored at town in Co with the Sea

Sunday March 28th lying at anchor at town

Monday March 29th out cruising saw several
nothing anchored at town

Tuesday March 30th out cruising saw several
got nothing anchored at Anvik

Wednesday March 31st out cruising chased
the Edward Lee got a whale anchored
at the rock April

Thursday April 1st out cruising saw several
chased got nothing at 6 P.M. anchored at Anvik

Friday April 2nd out cruising saw several
anchored at town 3 men sick. Cook off duty

Saturday April 3rd out cruising went out to
Anvik saw the Riffah off Chelting Day just out in a whale
anchored at town sick about the same

Sunday April 4th lying at anchor the L. & C. Cook
came on Capt. I can hunt in his boat - sick me
better

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Monday 5th lying at anchor. Cook off duty
on sick list - 10 others on sick list about the
same Capt. Atkins failing

Tuesday April 6th at anchor took 1 Boat on
repaired to go aboard. Capt. on shore. Capt. Atkins
died at 3 P.M. the Riffah & L. & C. Cook come
in set flag half mast

Wednesday April 7th lying at anchor Capt.
J. Parks on sick list at 12 M. went on shore
to Capt. Atkins funeral other sick the same

Thursday April 8th lying at anchor Capt. no better
W. Thayer on sick list Cook remains about the same

Friday April 9th lying at anchor all day at
7 P.M. got under weigh for St. Vincent Capt. no better

Saturday April 10th steam tracks & squally blow away
did nothing at 1 P.M. came to at Anvik. I
came on board. I anchored in the head of the Bay.
Went ashore for some medicines sick about the same

Sunday April 11th lying at St. Vincent - Capt.
no worse Thayer went on shore to his mother
Cook about the same

Monday April 12th lying at St. Vincent - Capt.
went to the Hospital Cook and Thayer improving.
fresh breeches & squally

Tuesday April 13th lying at St. Vincent - Capt.
on shore. Went to see them improving others improving
took morning cat fish stay & direct it refused nothing

Wednesday April 14th lying at St. Vincent -
Capt. improving Cook about well Thayer gaining
2 Carabals on deck one Berg
