Thursday April 15th lying at St Vincent -
Coff nearly recovered took on duty well
Shorey better one bark come in

Friday April 16th lying at St Vincent at
6 PM. Coff and Shorey come on board quite
recovered. Had 2 men ship John Dorethy and Frank Regan

Saturday April 17th lying at St Vincent one English
Bark arrived also Sch. M. Baker from N York. Museum
Shushet down fire & aft. Go into this day

Sunday April 18th lying at anchor at St Vincent
Shorey again this evening

Monday April 19th at 6 AM. got underweigh
short cut by the S. E. do several whips. Saw
one bird bound in to end this day Sunday 18th & 19th

Tuesday April 20th A.M. this day gentle trades
at 7 AM. tacked ship to the N. W. in
sight at 4 PM. tacked to the Eastward saw
one sail several finkacks

Wednesday April 21st A.M. this day gentle trades
at 11 AM. came to anchor at Barbados one
whaler in Port left went on shore. no business
being Regatta day

Thursday April 22nd lying at Barbados at
1 PM. just at Purchase bond commenced to break out
oil got 7 cask on deck. Cooped one one rig one in

Friday April 23rd lying at Barbados at
half past day hooped 10 casks oil set up 3
casks. 4 gally. one dr arrived & sailed

Saturday April 24th at Barbados got lighter
got 9 cask off deck set up 3 casks cooped & ready
for steaming. Squally & rough

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Sunday April 25th lying at Barbados

Monday April 26th lying at Barbados. broke out
the oil of our oil & casks cooped & filled them
Stew of Port side ground liver finished the day cooping

Tuesday April 27th lying at Barbados at 8 AM
got lighter got oil off deck 16 casks in all.
Market ~~at~~ salt number 1 to 16 12^{lb} 1/2 gal the
Bark was covered with 85 barrels this season
finished flying Stew of S. side & mung

Wednesday April 28th lying at Barbados
at 8 AM. Port watch went on shore on
36 hours liberty

Thursday April 29th at Barbados at 6 PM
Storboard watch went on shore one of Port watch
come off. Night only one man in fore castle

Friday April 30th lying at Barbados
finished Steaming hold filled & cask salt water

Saturday May 1st ^{May} lying Barbados at 9 AM
the Sch. M. G. & G. arrived came in. had taken
25 Sperm. that broke the good watch come off.
at 6 PM. got underweigh in co. with the Annies
for Demingue Steady W by N. N. all sail out

Sunday May 2nd A.M. this day gentle trades
at 12 M. made Demingue. at 8 PM. in the evening
came to anchor in co. with the Annies
Brig J. J. Small. Br. Matifourest & Ellen Regan
in Port

Monday May 3rd lying at Demingue in all
hands. Demingue. Steaming on salt water - 140
Barrels got cask ready for filling at 7 PM
Re. at got underweigh on in all this day.
got 3 men. Capt. Peter Porangues
