

Remarks on board Saturday March 27th
Came with pleasant breezes from SE by E.
saw three Islands New Island Lat 10° 06' S Long
121° 09' East and Low Island Lat 10° 37' S Long
122° 00' E, the latter part pleasant breezes.
The Island of saw in sight Lat 9° 55' S South
Long 122° 04' E

Remarks on board Sunday March 28th
Came with pleasant breezes from the southern
and eastward the Island of saw in
sight to the south the latter part light
breezes with the Island of saw in sight
to the SW Lat 10° 27' South

Remarks on board Monday March 29th
Came with light and baffling breezes the
Island of saw in sight 15 miles to the
westward the middle and latter part pleasant
breezes steering to the northward and
eastward saw the Island of Rota and the
Island of Tinian steering along with the
land saw a pinn Lat 9° 41' S Long 123° 12' E

Remarks on board Tuesday March 30th
Came with calms and light breezes and
baffling. Minac and Rotta in sight. The
latter part light breezes from the west
steering along with the land saw a
schooner, the land distance of about 4 miles

Remarks on board Wednesday March 31st
Came with pleasant breezes from the west at 7 P M
passed the rock Batagada Lat 8° 57' S Long 121° 55'
The latter part light breezes and calms a strong current
setting to the westward Batagada 15 miles to the westward

Remarks on board Thursday April 1st
Commenced with light breezes and calms the
land about the same distance off. saw two small
sails at 4 P M. We saw two large whales at sunset
struck one to the S boat and at 8 o'clock hooked
the line the latter part saw the whale and
hooked up the line to the W boat and struck
him the rock Batagada 5 miles to the west

Remarks on board Friday April 2nd
Came with light breezes and calms commenced
cutting at sunset got in his body the latter
part cut in his head and went to bowling head
ends with calms and strong current setting to
the west

Remarks on board Saturday April 3rd
Came with light breezes from the westward
steering to the eastward the land in sight
on both sides the middle and latter part
baffling light breezes

Remarks on board Sunday April 4th
Came with light breezes and calms steering
to the eastward at 4 P M finished bowling ends
with light breezes Lat 8° 50' S Long 127° 51' E

Remarks on board Monday April 5th
Came with light breezes the latter part much
the same steering along with the land a
plenty of black fish in site all of the time
