Came with strong breezes saw Denis Island  
and spoke the St Peters and the Triton with  
75000 S.P. the latter part strong breezes the two  
ships in sight Lat 33° 30' South Long

Remarks on board Friday Oct 13<sup>th</sup>  
Came with strong breezes with rain the two  
ships in sight the latter the same  
Lat 33° 35' South Long 36° 21' East

Remarks on board Saturday Oct 14<sup>th</sup>  
Came with strong breezes two ships in sight saw  
Cove Island spoke the St Peters she had struck  
a Whale and lost a line the middle and latter  
part the same Lat 33° 40' South Long 36° 11' E.

Remarks on board Sunday Oct 15<sup>th</sup>  
Came with strong breezes spoke the St Peters  
the latter part strong breezes the St Peters in  
sight Lat 33° 33' South Long 36° 25' E.

Remarks on board Monday Oct 16<sup>th</sup>  
Came with strong breezes saw Cove Island  
and St Peters the latter part light breezes  
the St Peters in sight Lat 33° 33' South Long 36° 36' E.

Remarks on board Tuesday Oct 17<sup>th</sup>  
Came with light breezes saw Denis Island  
and St Peters the latter part light breezes  
saw a shoal of Whales with Denis Island in  
sight Lat 33° 30' South Long 36° 40' E.

Remarks on board ~~Thursday~~ <sup>Wednesday</sup> Oct 18<sup>th</sup>  
Came with light breezes Whales in sight  
got three ones to each Boat Denis Island  
in sight the latter part cut in the Whales  
Lat 33° 35' S Long 36° 37' E

Remarks on board Thursday Oct 19<sup>th</sup>  
Came with light breezes cleared away the  
heads and commenced boiling at sunset the  
latter part light breezes and calmer with  
some rain boiling Lat 33° 42' South Long 36° 29' East

Remarks on board Friday Oct 20<sup>th</sup>  
Came with calmer boiling the latter part light  
breezes with some rain boiling  
no observation these 24 hours

Remarks on board Saturday Oct 21<sup>st</sup>  
Came with pleasant breezes finished boiling  
saw a shoal of Whales struck two to the St Boat  
trawled from one spouting blood struck two to  
the Larbot Boat struck from one spouting blood  
wounded the other and lost him struck two to the  
St Boat and drew from one the Larbot Boat  
killed one loose Whale and the St Boat one  
the latter part cut in the two Whales and found the  
St Boats Whale Lat 33° 34' South Long 36° 11' E.

Remarks on board Sunday Oct 22<sup>nd</sup>  
Came with light breezes took the Whale along side and cut him in the  
middle part recommenced boiling it rained and we cooled down  
the latter part boiling with showers of rain  
Lat 33° 22' South Long 36° 26' East
