Nov-20th Comes in with fine weather Wind North
Westerly Bk steering S.E. Hatch employ-
ed about ship duties
Middle part Very much the same
Bk under all sail Latter part wind
N.Easterly Employed as usual
Loat 33,50 L. Ed Garry Sick and off duty somewhat
Long 35,34 N. Billions

Sunday Nov 21st
These 24 hours begins with fine
breezes and squally weat. in Course S.E.
Hatch employed Reizing on Battens and
about ship duties Middle part wind S.E.
Bk heading to the S. West
Latter part Bk heading on Easterly
by the wind saw one sail and several
Sloops Ed Garry still off duty

Begins with fine and pleasant
weather Bk standing to the Eastward
by the wind one sail in sight
Middle part very much the same Bk
standing to the Southward under all sail

Begins with fine breezes from N.W.

under Double Reefed Topsails Latter part
Loat 30,30 more moderate saw jumpter watch employed
Long 28,11 about ship duties
Friday Nov 26th

Begins with fresh breezes from N.E. Bk steer-
ing S.E. under all sail watch employed as
usual saw one sail heading by the wind on
Starboard tack passed about 4 miles to
leeward of us a large Bk under two double
Topsails Foresail fift. & Shanker
Loat 28,37 saw also two Sloops
Long 26,50 Middle & latter part very much the same

Saturday Nov 27th
These 24 hours begins with fine pleasant
weather watch employed about ship duties
Bks Course S.E. wind westerly Middle part
Loat 29,91 same Latter part Westerly Bk at N.E. by S.
Long 25,75 saw several sail

Sunday Nov 28th
Begins with fine breezes from West
Bk steering E by S. watch employed about
ship duties started part Cask Bread
Middle part strong breezes from N.W. Course
E by S. Latter part very much the same
Loat 29,50
Long 22,39

Monday Nov 29th
Begins with strong breezes from N.W.
Bk steering E. by S. saw a number of Sloops
and 2 sail Middle part very much the
same Latter part employed breaking out
Hatch & Deck etc.
