

1846 Remarks on board Bark Clarice

Thursday June 2^d

Begins with moderate weather but some smoky Bark steering West by S. by S. one sail in sight a Whaler and steering about the same as we are Water employed washing ship at about 10 P.M. sighted a light on Barbadoes at 11 P.M. hove ship too. Litter just run down and anchored in Carlisle Bay, Barbadoes, at 11 A.M.

Saturday 3^d

First part Bark lying at anchor in Carlisle Bay. one boats crew ashore after recruits & remaining part of crew washing ship outside. Middle part light breeze at 5 A.M. hove up anchor and removed the ship to the place assigned her by the Harbour Master after Breakfast. Rent up tanks and began to Break out for Coopering at about 9.30 A.M. began Coopering oil

Sunday 4th

Begins with fine weather Bark at anchor in Carlisle Bay. all hands employed Coopering oil Coopered about 20 bbls litter just fine weather. all hands on board excepting Capt M and 2 officers

Monday 5th

Bark at anchor all hands employed Coopering oil and Shipping same put on board. 18 cask oil amounting to 3100 gals. Cask Marked (P.C. & R.) Branded B.K. Clarice and numbered according to quages

Tuesday 6th

All hands excepting 3^d mate Saml. Thomas employed breaking out and Coopering Oil. Finished at 6 P.M.

Wednesday 7th

Fine weather all hands on board employed painting ship & Shipping Oil on Board. Shipped 5894 galls. total 5894 galls. And the Capt of the Brig said that our oil was Coopered better than any he had taken

on a Whaling voyage in Atlantic Ocean
Thursday 8th

Bark at anchor in Carlisle Bay Barbadoes one watch on shore on liberty. Water employed setting up shovels

Friday 9th

Bark at anchor in Carlisle Bay Barbadoes. Starboard watch on shore on liberty. Starboard watch on board, with the exception of Charles Keeler Carpenter. Employed pumping Water out of the ground tier, setting up shovels &c &c

Saturday 10th

Still at anchor All hands on board except Chas Keeler, John Smith, Frank Mellen & Charles Brownell, Cook. Employed repairing and fitting ground tier setting up shovels &c &c. It might be well to state that the Cook stole away in the night from the ship

Sunday 11th

Bark at anchor Starboard watch on liberty

Monday 12th

Bark at anchor Barbadoes. John Adams, Scammon, & Saml. Goodrich Boarded returned to the ship but John Adams & Scammon returned to the ship but John Adams & Scammon returned to the ship. For the evening however Joseph Smith & Edward Stevens returned to the ship. Mr Thomas still on shore

Tuesday 13th

Bark at anchor Mr Thomas came off at day break. Took in 160 bbls water painted ship &c &c

Wednesday 14th

Spring this day. Starboard watch on shore on liberty. Took in 40 bbls water finished blowing off in lower hole & upper deck

Thursday 15th

Begins with fine weather at Sunrise. Rent in the Boat after liberty men part of them returned but John Smith, Bernard Reynolds, J. S. Cook did not return. Thinks they have deserted
