

1876 Remarks on Board of Bark Clarice

Saturday July 8th Begins with thick squally weather with strong breezes and some rain. Bark laying off & on at Bermuda Capt M. on shore run on close to land at 5 P.M. and at 6.30 P.M. but saw no signal for Boat. Tacked off at 6.30 P.M. Wind about N.E. weather squally & Barometer falling latter part light winds & calms bark working in to land

Sunday July 9th Begins with light airs from North, land bearing North. Bark under all sail working in at 1 P.M. sent on the waist boat land about 10 miles distant Boat landed at 6 P.M. and waited about 7.30 or until 8.30 P.M. when she came off Middle and latter part B.R. off and on at 8 A.M. Saw Blackfish lowered 3 boats without success

Monday July 10th Begins with fine weather and light breezes from the Eastward B.R. laying off & on at 1 P.M. End of Bermuda Capt on shore. Bark Leyda of A.B. also laying off & on. Saw Grampuses, Porpoises, Cowfish & ends this day

Tuesday July 11th Begins with strong breezes from the Westward Bark off & on at Bermuda in company with Bark Leyda (Pragor) at 5.30 P.M. spoke the Leyda Capt Pragor being on shore Mr. Kany came on board for about 3 hours Middle & latter part squally weather Bark off & on

Wednesday July 12th First part fine weather and light airs Bark under all sail laying off & on at Bermuda at 3.40 P.M. Capt M. signaled for a Boat sent on Boat & at 5 P.M. Capt M. came on board Middle part light airs latter part same. Watch employed about ship duty

1876 On A Whaling Voyage in Atlantic Ocean

Thursday July 13th First part light airs B.R. under all sail steering East. Watch employed about ship duty. Samuel Goodrich, John P. Cook under treatment for venereal disease John P. Cook off duty been so for about 10 or 15 days Middle & latter part light airs B.R. under all sail steering East Lat 32.16 Long 63.06

Friday July 14th First part light airs and calm B.R. under all sail steering East. Watch employed about ship duty. Middle & latter part very much the same B.R. steering E by N. Lat 32.00 Long 62.55 W

Saturday July 15th Begins with fine weather & light airs during night 2.15 P.M. saw a large whitewater bore away for it but did not see it again. Watch employed about ship duties. Middle & latter part fine breezes from about West B.R. steering E by N. Watch employed breaking out Tomogon, Symp, Water, Slope & Beef Lat 32.16 Long 62.24

Sunday July 16th Begins with fine breezes from the westward B.R. steering E by N. at about 1 P.M. lookout reported 3 points on Port bow went for them full headed but they proved to be dummers. Amished breaking out & washed rig & deck Middle and latter part strong breezes from West. Course E by N. Saml Goodrich off duty

Monday July 17th Comes on with fresh breezes from West B.R. steering E by N. 3rd mate has been unwell with sore eyes for some days today went off duty. Middle part light airs from East latter part light variable winds with light rain. All hands employed breaking out one cask of oil was leaking found it and started the oil into another cask loss about 15 gallons
