Tuesday July 18th Remarks on board Bark Blauie

First part light air and calm with
light rain Middle part same Latter part
same started 1 Cask Bread

Leath 33.26 Long 55.32

Wednesday July 19th

During these 24 hours light air and
calms Bark under all sail water employed
about ship duty Leath 33.42 N Long.

Thursday July 20th

Begins with fine weather and light air
and calm Bark steering East by North
Watch employed as usual Leath 34.09 Long 53.42

Friday July 21st

Begins with fine weather and light air
and calms at 3 o'clocks P.M. raised
breaches 12 miles off at 1.30 lowered
away the boats L.S. & W.B. in pursuit
Boats came up with the whales at and
struck one at sunset ship 6 miles off
got the whale along side at 12 midnight
rent all hands below latter part hooked
on and cut in the whale with the exception
of the case & Quirk Leath 34.09 Long 54.42

Saturday July 22nd

Leath 34.01
Long 53.18 Began with fine weather and light
air finished cutting and set the watch
saw one sail latter part started work
cleared away the head & 2 sail in sight

Sunday July 23rd

Begins with squally weather works
cooled down at 1.45 P.M. Watch started
the works. J.S. took on duty Middle & latter
part fine weather, Boiling,

Monday July 24th

Begins with fine breezes Bark on
port tack under 1/2 sail top sails fly fiddle
& spunkies Boiling Middle part squally
weathered Bark under easy sail Boiling
latter part finished Boiling Whale turned
up 1/2 bbl Leath 34.06 Long 52.32

On a whaling voyage in Atlantic Ocean
Tuesday July 25th

During these 24 hours fine breezes and
squally weather first and latter part
Bark steering N.E. Middle part of the wind
under easy sail Leath 35.27 Long 50.31

Wednesday July 26th

Begins with light breezes but
nick and cloudy weather Bark steering
N.E. Watch employed starting water &c. &c.
Middle & latter part very squally with heavy
rain Leath 35.22 Long 50.21

Thursday July 27th

First part light air & calms comes
to bark saw one sail Middle & latter part
strong breezes from S.E. latter part all hands
employed starting down &c. spoke B.K.
Sarah & Hale no oil this season Leath

Friday July 28th

Begins with strong breezes from
S.E. B.K. on Starboard tack all hands
employed starting down at 1.30 P.M.
finished. Whale starting down about 10 bbl
Middle & latter part strong breezes B.K. on
opposite tack water employed about
ship duty James partly off duty on acct. of
a rupture he has been troubled with it
before coming here Leath 35.43 Long 50.10

Saturday July 29th

First part strong breezes from
the Southward Bark steering different
courses, partly still off duty also same Goodrich
Middle part fine weather Bark under easy
sail, by the wind, on Starboard tack
latter part fine weather Bark on Starboard
tack under all sail Goodrich on duty
easy better Watch employed about
ship duty Leath 36.06 Long 49.18
