 Begins with strong breeze from S.W.
 hooked on to the Whells and cut them
 in (lost one head) finished cutting at
 7.30. P.M. and wore ship wind N.W.
 Barometer rising slowly Middle & latter
 part Boiling BK on Starboard tack

Wednesday 13th
 Log 41.57 Long 88.52
 During these 24 hours variable wind
 and squally weather BK on Port tack
 Boiling

Thursday 14th
 During these 24 hours strong
 breeze & squally weather at 6 P.M.
 finished Boiling saved about 35 bbls.
 of oil saw a number of sail
 Log 41.38 Long 88.00

Friday 15th
 Begins with fine weather with a
 heavy swell Wind N.W. BK on
 Starboard tack under Close reefed
 Main top sail Double reefed fore
 & fore sail Gibby & Apaukes. plenty of
 fish around the ship All hands employed
 washing ship and breaking out molasses
 & sugar saw 2 sail Middle part very
 much the same latter part more moderate.
 BK under whole top sails & courses
 All hands employed stowing down Log 42.25
 Long 89.15

Saturday Sept 16th
 Commenced with fine breeze from
 the Northward BK steering West
 finished stowing down, stowed down 35 bbls.
 Middle part fine weather BK under short
 sail latter part fine weather wind
 Easterly BK under all sail heading
 S.W. Watch employed about ship duty
 Log 43.55 A
 Long 89.34 W

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Sunday Sept 17th
 Fair & fine weather & light
 air BK under all sail & steering
 different courses & plenty of Albicore
 and Skipjacks around saw one sail
 John Cabote Boulsteeve sick & off duty
 on acct of a fall Middle part strong
 breeze and squally weather BK by the main
 on Port tack latter part fresh gale from
 S.W. BK on Starboard tack
 no observation

Monday 18th
 Begins with fresh gale from N.W.
 BK on Starboard tack under Close reefed
 Main top sail & fore top mast top sail
 At dark wore ship & set the fore sail
 Middle part very much the same took
 on the fore sail latter part fresh gale
 reefed everything and took craft out
 of the boats Barometer low down to 29 in

Tuesday 19th
 During these 24 hours fresh gale from
 N.W. BK on Port tack at 4.30 hoisted away
 the Main top sail latter part saw 2 sail

Wednesday 20th
 Comes in with fresh gale from N.W.
 2 sails in sight one fore top under Close Reefed
 Main top sail and fore top mast top sail
 the other flying before the wind under double
 reefed & fore sail Clarice on Port tack with
 fore top mast top sail, Mizzen & fore top mast top sail
 out Middle & latter part very much the same
 J.P. Cook sick & off duty Kidney Complaint
 J. Adams off duty (Cange) a fall during the night
 Barometer rising slowly Log 44.31 Long 89.33

Thursday Sept 21st
 Comes in with fresh gale from N.W.
 BK have two on Port tack under fore top mast top sail Mizzen
 & fore top mast top sail latter part more moderate
 set the fore sail & double reef fore top sail
 Put the craft in the boats &c &c
