

1876 Bk Clarice at St. Miguel

Sunday 15th

Bk moored inside the Breakwater at San Miguel All hands on Board except Joseph Smith. Heaving a man on board in his place Employed Pumping Salt & Fresh Water, blowing ground tier & Vc Middle part one watch on shore latter part Starboard watch on shore on Liberty

Monday 16th

Begins with rainy weather on watch on shore on Liberty Middle part same Latter part all hands on Board excepting Joseph Smith Employed getting read back for blowing & for rafting

Tuesday 17th

All hands on board excepting Joseph Smith Employed Rafting water pumping Bends lifting the ship for the purpose of repairing the Copper & C. Latter part sent on raft but could not fill it (no water in tank) took the raft on board all hands on board Baking cake for ground tier and filling Cask with salt water

Wednesday 18th

Comes in with fine weather all hands on board Employed lifting the ship washing ship & taking in 26 Cords of wood finished lifting ship and repairing Copper Employed a diver to nail on a piece of Copper below our reach finished at dark Latter part all hands employed getting water

Thursday 19th

First part fine weather all hands employed getting water from Bk Apurcan 10 tons along for Ballast Middle part 1 watch employed on shore latter part fine weather all hands employed getting water Ballasting the ship & Vc from Adams Regimen Went to the Hospital today has been complaining of the Rheumatism for some weeks (and been off duty) We do not think any thing anything as the matter with him

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Oct 20th

First part fine weather all hands employed Ballasting the ship & Vc Middle part all hands on shore

Latter part all hands excepting John Adams Employed blowing hole but so little water

Saturday 21st

First part fine weather finished blowing hole and washed ship outside & in Middle part one watch on shore Latter part Watch on shore on Liberty Watch Employed getting water

Sunday Oct 22nd

First part thick weather with light rain Latter part waited on shore on Liberty Middle part same Latter part C. & Vc and Ed Perry did not return to the ship but broke their liberty which was up at 2 PM

Monday

Oct 23, 1 but broke their liberty which was up at 2 PM First part thick cloudy weather wind to the South Starboard watch on Liberty Norton & Perry still absent 3rd officer also absent Latter part fresh Gale from N.W. Thomas Fisher, John Smith, Trott, John Boatman & B. Reynolds broke their liberty Got off 1 small raft water

Tuesday 24th

First part strong breeze & rain Fisher, John & returned to the ship Mr. Thomas, John Doe Smith, Remond Reynolds, C. & Norton & Ed Perry absent Latter part same Starboard watch on shore, Starboard watch employed painting ship

Wednesday 25th

Commences with fine weather Starboard watch on shore on Liberty Starboard watch employed painting ship the Absent ones still absent Middle same Latter part Joseph Smith & Trott returned to the ship But Westgate, Plando Rogers, Popple Brown, John L. Cook & J. G. Symonds broke their liberty at 7 AM. Employed painting
