Saturday 10th

Came in with fine breeze from S. & S. W. at 2.30 P.M. Came to the wind on Starboard tack & sail in sight at sundown shortened sail and wore ship. Latter part strong trades. Bark on Starboard tack spoke scho. Sarah E. Lewis & weeks out clean.

Sunday 11th

During these 24 hours strong trades. Bark on opposite tack cruising. Fair part in company with S. E. Lewis Capt. J. Cook. Latter part saw 2 sail.

Monday 12th

During these 24 hours fine weather and fine breeze from S. & S. W. Bark on opposite tack. Cruising saw several sail. Watch employed as usual.

Lat 12.26

Long 39.03

Tuesday 13th

During these 24 hours fresh breeze from S. & S. W. Bark on opposite tack. Fair and latter part under all sail. Great of the time. Watch employed about ship duty. The man who broke his leg. On duty again all well.

During these 24 hours fine breeze from S. & S. W. Bark on opposite tack. Middle under short sail. Latter part started water.

During these 24 hours fine weather and fresh breeze. Bark on opposite tack and cruising. Different courses. Saw Porpoise and Blackfish. Started 148 Gulls water and 1 cask flour & one of bread.

Saturday 17th

All these 24 hours fine weather and fine breeze from S. & S. W. Bark on opposite tack. Cruising saw one sail. Employed about ship duty.

Lat 12.36

Long 39.58

Sunday 18th

During these 24 hours fine weather and fine breeze from S. & S. W. Bark on opposite tack and cruising. Employed about ship duty.

Lat 12.41

Long 39.43

Monday 19th

During these 24 hours fine weather and fine breeze from S. & S. W. Bark on opposite tack. Daytime under all sail. Saw Codfish. Watch employed about ship duty. Started Bark.

Lat 13.00 Long 39.33

Tuesday 20th

Fair part fine weather and fine breeze from S. & S. W. Bark on Starboard tack under all sail. Saw Grampass & small fish. Started Beef. At sundown took in night sails and went about. Latter part fine weather. Bark on Port tack with blamie. Gulltail fly fish and 150 Gulls. Saw one sail.
