Wednesday Feb 21st
During these 24 hours fine weather and moderate trades Bark on opposite tack cruising Watch employed as usual
Lat 11.33 Long 38.59

Thursday Feb 22nd
During these 24 hours fine weather and fine breeze (Northeastly) Bark on Starboard tack by the wind saw 3 finbacks
Lat 12.38 Long 39.16

Friday Feb 23rd
During these 24 hours fine weather and fine breeze from the Eastward Bark on opposite tack saw a number of finbacks Watch employed about ship duty
Lat 12.33 Long 39.03

Saturday Feb 24th
During these 24 hours fine weather and fine breeze (Northeastly) Bark cruising and opposite tack Watch employed as usual
Lat 12.21 Long 38.58

Sunday Feb 25th
During these 24 hours fine weather and fine breeze from E.N.E. Bark on opposite tack cruising
Lat 12.32 Long 38.34

Monday Feb 26th
During these 24 hours fine weather and fine breeze from E.N.E. Bark on opposite tack
Lat 12.27 Long 38.38

Tuesday Feb 27th
During these 24 hours fine weather and moderate trades at 2.30 P.M. spoke Bark George & Massy of New Bedford (Cannon 21 months out 280 bbls all told) started Deep
Lat 12.30 Long 38.38

March Of Edgartown (Merchant)

Wednesday Feb 28th
Came in with fine weather and fine breeze from E.N.E. Bark by the wind on Starboard tack Geo & Massy in sight to leeward
Lat 14.00 Long 38.34

Thursday Mar 1st
All these 24 hours fine weather Bark on opposite tack (cruising) saw 2 sail and 3 finbacks Watch employed about ship duty
Lat 14.03 Long 38.29

Friday Mar 2nd
During these 24 hours variable winds and calm Bark cruising saw Porpoise employed about ship duty
Lat 14.18 Long 38.10

Saturday Mar 3rd
Came in with fine weather with light variable breeze and Calm Lat 14.08 Long 38.14

Sunday Mar 4th
Came in with light air and Calm Hatched Ship etc. and went on swimming At sundown furled the light sails Lat 13.40 Long 38.51

Monday Mar 5th
Came in with fine weather and light breeze from E.N.E. Bark on Port tack under all sail at sundown shortened sail at daylight made sail saw 2 sail (Whalemen) at 7 A.M. kept the ship S.W. (no end)
