Tuesday 6th

Came in with fine weather & fine breeze
Bark steering N.W. by W at 2.15 P.M. started
J.W. saw Gribacks & one sail at Sundown
took in the light sails & courses and came
to the wind on Port tack Latter part fresh
trades at daylight started N.W. on sail
in sight Watch employed Breaking out
Water Lead 12.18 Long 38.34

Wednesday 7th

Came in with fresh breeze from N.E. Bark
steering N.W. under Whole topails
at 2 P.M. spoke Bark Swallow N.E.
Capt. Bled 11 months out 6.50 Bled 11 months
Gained partly & P.M. Latter part fresh
breeze from N.E. Bark on Port tack under
double reef, courses, Gibb & Spanker
Lead 12.22 Long 38.44

Thursday 8th

Came in with fresh breeze from N.E.
Bk on Port tack by the wind at 2.30 P.M.
Passed Bk Swallow At Sundown double
reefed & furled the Courses at Daylight wore
ship and made sail Latter part fine
weather nothing in sight
Lead 12.20 Long 38.43

Friday 9th

Came in with fine pleasant weather
Bark on Starboard tack at 4.45 P.M.
raised Blackfish Cleared away L.I.
W.B. & B.B. returned at dusk without
succeed, W.B. struck and drewed
Middle and Latter part fine weather
Watch employed as usual Lead 12.48 Long 38.57

Saturday 10th

During these 24 hours strong breezes
from N.E. Bark cruising at 2.45 P.M.
saw Gumpers and at 3 P.M. Blackfish
Middle part Bark under easy sail
Latter part Bk steering N.W. by W. & N.W.
Lead 12.40 Long 39.13

Sunday 11th

Came in with fine weather Bark steering
N.W. at 8⁰⁰ P.M. Began the yards and brought
her to the wind on Starboard tack At Sundown
furled the Courses at Daylight made all sail
and wore ship weather fine and pleasant no wind
Lead 12.46 Long 38.39

Monday 12th

During these 24 hours fine weather
and moderate trades Bk. on opposite
tack, first & latter part under all sail
Middle under Whole Main double reefed fore-
topails, Courses Gibb & Spanker Latter
part Watch employed Breaking out
Water at 11.30 saw Blackfish and
pursued in chase Lead 12.20 Long 38.43

Tuesday 13th

Came in with fine weather Boats down
after Blackfish at 3 P.M. returned with
3 Blackfish Cleared away the Blackfish
up at Sundown came on stage & took in
the light sails and courses Middle & latter part
light air at 11.30 made sail
Latter part gained the blubber & etc
Lead 12.32 Long 38.31

Wednesday 14th

Came in with light air Bk. on Starboard
tack under all sail at 4.45 P.M. started the
work at Sundown came on stage and took in
the light sails and courses Middle & latter part
fine weather finished boiling Blackfish
at daylight made all sail and came on stage
Lead 12.58 Long 38.25

Thursday 15th

During these 24 hours light air and
calms saw Blackfish & equal
Watch employed as usual
Lead 13.26 Long 38.16
