 Comes in with fresh breeze from E.N.E.
 Bark on Starboard tack in company with
 Bark Sarah B. Hale at 4 P.M. run down
 and took our Bread Cask on board full of
 Fresh water from the S.B. H. In putting a Cask
 overboard on board of the S.B. H. J.R. Vincent
 got his leg jammed Middle Mast Bark on
 Port tack under short sail at sundown wore
 ship and stood to the northward after breakfast
 stowed down last fare of oil about 24 bbls
 started 4 1/2 bbls beef Load 12.20 Long 38.07

Wednesday 28th
 Comes in with light breeze but
 smokes Bark on Starboard tack by the wind
 at 4 P.M. wore ship at sundown furlled
 the Courses Jib & Sprung Middle & latter Mast
 fine weather saw 2 shoals of Blackfish
 Load 12.52 Long 38.13

Thursday 29th
 During these 24 hours fine weather
 and light breeze Bark on opposite
 tack saw 1 shoal of Blackfish
 Watch employed about ship duty
 Load 12.46 Long 38.36

Friday 30th
 All these 24 hours fine weather first Mast
 light breeze spoke the S.B. Hale at 5:30 P.M.
 spoke gamel until 8:30 P.M. latter part fine
 breeze Bark steering different courses
 S.B. Hale in sight Load 12.42 Long 38.57

Saturday 31st
 During these 24 hours strong trades
 Bark on opposite - tacks saw 2 sail
 and spoke Bark Leannee (Dawden)
 22 months out 8 to bbls 8 Nov Load 12.3 Long 38.43

Sunday April 1st
 Comes in with strong trades Bark on
 3rd tack at 4:30. Gamed Bk chances
 Load 12.18 Long 38.21

Tuesday April 3rd
 Fine part fine weather Bark on Port
 tack by the wind saw Porpoise started Bread
 Middle and latter Mast strong breeze
 Bark on opposite tacks Load 12.45 Long 38.11

Wednesday 4th
 During these 24 hours strong breeze
 Bark on opposite tacks saw one sail
 Load 13.02 Long 38.13

Thursday 5th
 First part fine breeze Bark on Starboard
 tack under Whole Main top sail & double reefed the
 Courses, Jib & gafftop sail at sundown
 shortened sail and went about one Whaler
 in sight At sundown wore ship and set
 the Courses to end this day

 Latter part Bark steering N.W.

 First part strong trades Bark
 steering N.W. shifted the 3rd top sail
 At sundown shortened sail Bk by the wind
 on Starboard tack latter part strong trades
 Bark under double reefed Jib & gaff
 steering N.W. at 9:30 A.M. raised the S.B. H.
 and spoke her at 11. Had seen nothing
