Tuesday 10th

Finest part fine weather at 3.30 P.M. spoke Bark Looney had been making good until dark. Latter part strong breeze Bark steering N.W. Broke out water. Leads 41.35 Long 14.02

Wednesday 11th

All these 24 hours strong breezes. Bark under easy sail steering different. Course saw several sail. Leads 13.40 Long 42.13

Thursday 12th

Finest part strong breezes. Bark steering different. Course saw several sail at 4.50 P.M. spoke Bark Perry (Bassett) 65-660. This reason yamied until 10 P.M. Middle & latter part strong breezes at 7 A.M. wore ship and stood to the N.W. Leads 13.60 Long 42.18

Friday 13th

All these 24 hours fresh breezes. Bark on opposite tacks steering different. Course saw a number of Whalers. Leads 13.44 Long 42.40

All these 24 hours strong breezes. Bark on opposite tacks saw a number of Whalers. Employed as usual. Leads 13.22 Long 42.06

Sunday 15th

Finest part strong breezes. Bark on Port tack steering S.E. at 2 P.M. passed Bk. Lumberton at sundown. Double reefed, fished the Course, fished & spunked at daylight wore ship and made sail so ends lead 13.26 Long 42.00

Monday 16th

Came in with fine weather & fine breezes. Bark on Starboard tack by the wind saw 2 sail at sundown took on sail. Latter part Bk by the wind on Port tack saw 1 sail. Water employed breaking out. Leads Beef Pork & Molasses. Leads by Obs. 13.17 Long by Chron. 41.50

Tuesday 17th

All these 24 hours fine weather. Bark on opposite tacks and steering different. Course saw several sail. Leads 13.27 Long 42.31

Wednesday 18th

Finest part fine weather at 4.30 P.M. spoke Bark A. R. Tucker 4 months out 175 lbs. yamied until 10 P.M. in company with Bk. Petrel (Downs) & Bk. Thopie Bird (Tilton). Latter part fine weather. Bark on Port tack saw 2 sail. Broke out water. Leads 13.22 Long 42.31

Thursday 19th

Finest part fine weather. Bark on Port tack under all sail at 2 P.M. saw Bk. Petrel cutting. Saw a number of sail. Porpoises & small fish. Middle and latter part fine weather saw several sail. Leads 13.36 Long 42.37

Friday 20th

All these 24 hours fine weather but some Bk. on opposite tacks saw several Whalers and Blackfish.
