

May 3rd 1877 Remarks on board Bark Clavier

Wednesday All these 24 hours fine weather spoke and jammed Bark under all sail cruising Employed about ship duty
Lat 12.42 Long 42.28

Thursday 3rd All these 24 hours fine weather and fine breeze Bark on opposite tacks, first & latter part under full sail, spoke & jammed Wm. X. Grosier (Robert), 1 weeks out 25 bbls
Lat 12.48 Long 43.03

Friday 4th All these 24 hours fine weather and fine breeze from S.W. Bark sleeping different courses saw a number of sail sent on the fly. Gibb for repairs and out again
Lat 13.34 Long 42.49

Saturday 5th All these 24 hours fine weather and fine breeze first and latter part Bark on opposite tacks and sleeping different courses Middle part under easy sail
Lat 13.06 Long 43.34

Sunday 6th All these 24 hours fine weather and fine breeze from East Bark on opposite tacks saw gulls, and one Whaling schooner
Lat 13.13 Long 43.38

Monday 7th Fairer part fine weather Bark on Port tack by the wind saw one sail Middle & latter part strong trades spoke and jammed Reht C. H. Hatfield (Cornell) 5 months out 30 whale
Lat 13.48 Long 43.51

Tuesday 8th All these 24 hours strong trades Bark on opposite tacks Cruising saw a number of sail. Watch employed repairing old Gibb
Lat 12.54 Long 43.35

May 1877 On A. Whaling voyage (Marchant)

Wednesday 9th Opening these 24 hours strong trades Bark on Starboard tack by the wind saw one sail. Cooper sick and off duty feet, legs and arms swollen also private. supposed to be caused by medicine which he had been taking. finished repairing Gibb

Thursday 10th Lat 13.53 Long 43.32 Fairer part strong trades Bark on Port tack under double reefed courses, Gibb & Shanker at Rundown furled mainsail Gibb & Shanker and wore ship latter part strong trades Bark on Port tack by the wind under double reefed & foresail. Broke out 4 1/4 bbls Beef
Lat 13.15 Long 42.56

Friday 11th Came in with strong trades Bark on Port tack by the wind under Double reefed & foresail at Rundown furled the foresail & mainsail nothing in sight Middle part squally. at daylight wore ship & set foresail & mainsail Bark by the wind at 10 A.M. kept the ship N.W. until 11.30 A.M. Lat 13.06 Long 43.45

Saturday 12th Came in with strong trades Bark by the wind on Starboard tack at Rundown furled foresail & mainsail and wore ship weather squally and cloudy latter part strong breeze at sunrise wore ship and steered N.W. Lat 13.24 Long 43.31

Sunday 13th Came in with strong trades Bark under double reefed foresail & Gibb steering N.W. at 12.30 P.M. wore ship and altered S.W. saw one sail at Rundown furled foresail & Gibb and came to the wind on Port tack latter part strong breeze at daylight wore ship and altered N.W. set the foresail and Gibb. Saw 2 shoals Blackfish
