Broke out Beef & Pork
Lat 13.18 Long 37.30

Sunday 17th Lat 13.10 Long 37.23
During this day fine weather
and moderate trades at 6 A.M.
saw a large school of Blackfish
and at 4.30 a lone rail
Lat 12.52 Long 37.23

Monday 18th Sept. 1891
Fair - first fine weather
Bk on Post-tack under all sail
at 3 P.M. Came in at anchor at 4.30 P.M.
spoke Capt. Rivington, Reginald
& months out clean fresh looks
Capt. Barrow on Cornhill ground with
160 bbls this season Middle & Lard
along trades Bk on opposite
tacks

cruising saw 2 sail employed as
usual. Left 13.41 Long 37.5.7

During these 24 hours
strong trades Bk on opposite
tack cruising to thing along
Gate 12.12
Long 37.40
all at

Thursday 21st at Long 37.40
During these 24 hours along
trades B.K on opposite tracks Cruising
saw 2 rail Leathes Inst - Employed
Repairing Foreail paid 13.00
Friday 22^d Long 36.19

Friday 29^d
 Comes in with strong trades
 Bk on Starboard tack steering N. W
 At 3 P.M. Came to the wind on
 same tack at sundown shortened sail
 and came wore ship. Leaves Port
 strong trades Bk on Port tack under
 double Reef. Broke out 186 & 140
 Gall's water. Lat. 12. 27
 Long. 38 21

Saturday 23
During the 24 hours
moderate trade. Back on special-
tasks cruising saw one rail.
Gamed B.H. Matisporiaetta (Longwing)
18 on the out 100 Spar. & 140 W. B. O.
Left 12.32
Leaving 38.41
