Sunday Feb 24th Remarks on board Bk. Clarice

First part moderate trades
Bk on Starboard tack steering N.W.
the Mattapoisett in sight at 2.30
PM sighted a Whaling Bk and
sprung on the Weather Beam
spoke and gunned them. Bk Loagoda
saw us & Bk Francis Barstow (Reed)
later part strong trades spoke Bk
Loagoda and gunned.

Monday 25th

Saw
Blackfish

First part light trades
Bk steering S.W. in company with
Bk. Loagoda (saw us). Gunned until
Eight PM. Later part strong trades
the Loagoda in sight. Flying fish and
small fish in great abundance.

Came in with moderate trade
Bk by the wind on Starboard tack
at sundown wore ship Middle &
later part Bk on Port tack. at 7 PM.
left the ship S. E. W. Employed as usual

Tuesday 26th

During these 24 hours
fine weather and fine breezes Bk
on opposite tacks and steering different
courses saw Finback's fish one
calf

Wednesday 27th

During these 24 hours
fine weather First part moderate
trades. Later strong trades
Bk on opposite tacks and steering
different courses working to
the westward

Friday March 1st Remarks on board Bark Clarice

During these 24 hours strong trades
Bk on opposite tacks & steering different
courses working to the westward
Later part started 353 galls Water also
one bbl Beef & 1 Pork Lat 12.08 Long 41.53

Saturday 2nd

During these 24 hours fine
weather and moderate breezes Bk on
opposite tacks cruising Spoke Brig
Heman Smith of Boston (Capt) 4 months
out clean later part broke out
molasses

Sunday 3rd

First part moderate trades
Bk on Starboard tack by the wind
under all sail Middle under short
sail At 7 AM wore ship and steered
to the south until 10.30 AM. then were
back to Bk saw one sail

Lat 13.01 Long. 42.01

Monday 4th

Came in with strong trades
Bk by the wind on Starboard tack
at 4.30 PM. saw 2 points to windward
came in stays and at 5 saw a bunch
on weather bow night coming on
saw nothing more Middle part on oppos-
ite tacks under easy sail later
by the wind on Starboard tack saw
nothing

Tuesday 5th

During these 24 hours Bk on
Starboard tack by the wind
Bound to the Western Isles Weather
good but winds variable and well
to the Northward
