May 9<sup>th</sup> Remarks on board the  
First part strong gale from  
N.W. but equally with rain at 4  
P.M. more moderate - set Close Reefed  
Foretopsail Barometer 28.80 & 100  
At 7 set Whole Main topsail and light  
and veering to the north at 8.30 were thick  
wind N.E. At 2 P.M. wind began  
to blow a gale from N.E. Tied Foretopsail  
& Foresail & Close Reefed Main topsail  
At 6 Wind blowing a severe gale from  
N.E. Sawsawing Main topsail & set  
Reefed Rigger staysail  
Lat 42.18 Long 24.18

Friday 10<sup>th</sup>  
Came in with strong gale  
from north but not so heavy as above  
Bk under same sail Bar. 29.8 rising  
slowly At 8 P.M. set Close Reefed Foretop  
sail and wore ship Middle equally  
& running latter part very much the  
same wore ship at 8 A.M. wind  
slight blowing a gale from the north  
Bar 29.210 Lat 42.45 Long 26.59

Saturday 11<sup>th</sup>  
Came on with strong gale  
from the north. Bk under Close Reefed  
Topsails on Port-tack Bar. 29.15  
Middle very much the same Bar 29.20  
Latter part wind veered to N.W. and  
began to blow a severe gale Bar. fell to  
29.10 Lat 43.02 Long 26.21

Sunday 12<sup>th</sup>  
Came on with strong gale from N.W.  
Bk on Port tack under close reefed topsails  
saw 2 sail At 4 P.M. more moderate  
set Reefed Foresail Middle very much  
the same latter more moderate set Double  
Reefed Main topsail Whole Foresail Gibb  
& Spanker with 4.16 Long 24.54

1878  
May Monday 13<sup>th</sup>  
Came on with High winds from  
N.W. Bk by the wind on Port-tack under  
sail as before. Bar. 29.10 Saw several  
sulfurbottoms Middle more moderate  
set Whole Main topsail & Flyjibb Latter part  
Main sail & Whole Foretopsail & Spanker  
Saw 2 sail Lat 46.08 Long 25.29

Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup>  
First part strong windy Bk  
by the wind Double reefs & Courses heading  
about N.E. Middle & Latter part more  
moderate saw numerous Sulfurbottoms  
and one sail Broke gun Broad  
Latitude by obs 48.54 North  
Longitude by Chron 25.10 West

Wednesday May 15<sup>th</sup>  
During these 24 hours  
variable winds from the Northward &  
Eastward Bk working to the Northward  
saw several Sulfurbottoms Broke out Molasses  
Latter part Hatched employed trimming  
Ship Cook off duty Cause Ruelbo

Thursday May 16<sup>th</sup>  
variable winds Bk working to the Northward Bar. 28.50  
saw Grampases Birds & drift wood & timber  
Hatched Employed about ship duty  
Cook off duty Cause Ruelbo  
Latitude by obs. 49.56  
Longitude by Chron 24.30
