First & Middle part fine breeze & steaming Bk under all sail steering for the N. E. in company with the Minerva Middle under short sail on Starboard tack latter part strong winds from S. S. E. Bk on opposite tacks and steaming different courses, saw a number of Merchant ships & steamers also one Whaler

Came in with a moderate gale from S. S. E. Bk by the wind on Starboard tack under double reefs Middle more moderate latter part strong breeze from S. S. W. Bk by the wind on Starboard tack under Double Reefed Main topsail. Close fore gible Sparker & Correes weather thick & foggy
