

1878 Remarks on board Bark

Friday July 26th All these 24 hours light-
winds and calm Bark on opposite
tacks working to the S.W. saw several
sail vessels employed about ship duty

Long 26.53

Saturday 27th All these 24 hours light-
breezes from N.E.W. and fine weather
Bark under all sail steaming for the
wind on Starboard tack Employed
as usual

Lat 41.52

Long 26.57

Sunday July 28th All these 24 hours fine
weather and light - westerly winds
Bark under all sail steaming N.E.W.
saw one sail

Lat 40.38

Long 28.34

Monday July 29th All these 24 hours light-
airs and calm Bk. working to the
Westward from the foretopmast yard badly
sprung, latter part employed fitting
a new one saw 3 sail.

Lat 40.34

Long 29.16

Tuesday July 30th All these 24 hours light-
variable winds S.E. Bk. under all sail
steaming N by S.W. sent up meat Foretopmast
yard saw 15 merchantmen

Wednesday July 31st

All these 24 hours light-
breezes and calm weather Bk. under
all sail steaming N.W.S.

1878 Clarice of Edgartown - (Marchant)

August 1st

Came in with fine breeze from S.W. Bark
by the wind on Port-tack at 2 P.M. sighted
Clarice (right ahead) dist. 20 miles
Middle and latter part light-variable
winds Bk. working in to land at 9 A.M.
Capt. Mc. went off shore taking one of the cases
of rum and the Doctor pronounced it - a very
bad case

Friday Aug 2nd

Came in with fine weather Bk.
off and on at Santa Cruz. Could not get
our recruits off on acct of it being steam
day Capt. came off at sundown Middle
part strong gale split the ribs trying to
hold on latter part high winds Bk. trying
to work in at 10 Wind about N. and
barometer bearing about N.E.W.

Saturday Aug 3rd

Came in with high winds
from the Northward Bk. working up to
Santa Cruz at 7 P.M. arrived off the
town Middle and latter moderate breezes
Bk. off & on at 7 A.M. Capt. Mc. went on
shore & at 11 the recruits came off

Sunday Aug 4th

Came in with light airs
from the Eastward at 3 P.M. Capt.
came off Middle & latter part
Bk. working to the westward latter part
with a strong breeze from E.S.E. Course
N.W.W. Lat 39.23 Long 32.46
