

1878 Remarks on board Bark Clives
 Aug. Monday 8th
 Comes in with strong winds
 from East BK along N.W. W. W. W.
 Middle & latter part very much the
 same Lat 39.31 Long 36.26

Tuesday 6th
 During these 24 hours
 light variable winds first part
 repaired Main sail
 Latter part broke out Water & Horn
 Sugar & Coffee Lat 38.20 Long 36.46

Wednesday 7th
 First and Middle parts
 light breeze from the Westward BK
 on opposite tack latter part very much
 the same Watch employed repairing
 Main top sail to observation

Thursday Aug 8th
 All these 24 hours
 variable winds equally weather & working
 to the westward Finished the Main top sail

Friday Aug 9th
 First part strong breezes
 (Westward) and equally weather Middle
 & latter part fine weather & breezes N. Westward
 by Watch employed as usual Lat 38.02 Long 39.20

Saturday Aug 10th
 During these 24 hours
 fine weather and strong breezes from N.W.
 BK by the wind on Starboard tack under
 all sail Employed as usual Lat 37.03
 Long 40.34

1878 Bound to the Terror Ground
 Sunday Aug 11th

All these 24 hours fine weather
 and moderate breezes & Westward Back
 on opposite tack, working to the westward
 and changed the Main top sail
 Lat 36.52
 Long 41.02

Monday Aug 12th
 All these 24 hours strong
 breezes & Westward BK by the wind on Port tack
 latter part split the Gilt & bent in its place
 a new Main top mast stay sail Lat 38.24
 Long 43.18

Tuesday Aug 13th
 First and Middle parts
 strong winds & Westward BK under double
 reefed Courses, Gilt & Sprinker latter on Port
 tack latter part thick, hazy, & equally weather
 BK under short sail & on opposite tack
 working to the N.W. Broke out Water
 Lat 38.49
 Long 43.34

Wednesday Aug 14th
 First & Middle light air
 from the Eastward BK under all sail along
 N.W. latter part strong winds Westward BK
 by the wind on Port tack Employed hauling
 down fore rigging Lat 39.24
 Long 44.54

Thursday 15th
 During these 24 hours light
 variable winds BK under all sail working
 to the N.W. saw several sail also
 spruce. Porpoises & Sperm whales &c
 repaired the Gilt Lat 40.10
 Long 45.46
