

Thursday Dec 5th 1878

First part blowing a moderate gale from the N. by the wind on Starboard tack. Middle part later part blowing a gale from the N. by the wind on B. tack.

Lat. $24^{\circ} 50' N.$ Long $28^{\circ} 30' W.$

Friday Dec 6th

First part blowing a gale from the N. and squally later the old Starboard tack. Middle part more moderate later part strong breeze and squally steering S. by E.

Lat. $23^{\circ} 40' N.$ Long $28^{\circ} 15' W.$

Saturday Dec 7th 1878

First part strong breeze from the N. steering S. by E. Middle part later part strong breeze from the N. steering by the wind on Starboard tack.

Lat. $22^{\circ} 14' S.$ Long $27^{\circ} 57' W.$

Sunday Dec 8th

Strong breeze from the N. and squally steering by the wind on Starboard tack. The same throughout the day.

Latitude $20^{\circ} 25' N.$ Long $27^{\circ} 53' W.$

Monday Dec 9th

First part fresh breeze from the N. steering by the wind on Starboard tack. Middle part the same. Later part fresh breeze from the N. steering S. by E.

Lat. $18^{\circ} 25' N.$ Long $27^{\circ} 30' W.$

Tuesday Dec 10th 1878

First part fine light breeze from the West steering S. by E. Middle part light air from the N. steering S. by E. Latter part light air from the N. by the wind. Passed the Island of St. Anne at 9 o'clock A.M. bearing S. by E. by compass.

Lat. $17^{\circ} 15' N.$ Long $26^{\circ} 12' W.$

Wednesday Dec 11th 1878

First part light air from the S.W. on Starboard tack until 5 o'clock A.M. when grew around. Wind and later part light variable winds, first on one tack then the other.

Lat. $17^{\circ} 02' N.$ Long $27^{\circ} 08' W.$

Thursday Dec 12th 1878

First part light variable winds and calm. Latter part light air from the N. S.W. steering S. by E.

Lat. $16^{\circ} 30' N.$ Long $26^{\circ} 59' W.$

Friday Dec 13th

First part light air from the N. S.W. steering S. by E. Middle part calm. Latter part light air from the N. steering S. by E.

Lat. $16^{\circ} N.$ Long $26^{\circ} 15' W.$

Saturday Dec 14th

First part light air from the S. E. steering S. by E. Middle part fresh breeze. Latter part more moderate. Entered the Island of Java at 7 o'clock P.M.

Lat. $14^{\circ} 42' N.$ Long $26^{\circ} 04' W.$
