

Sunday Jan. 5th 1879.

First part calm, lowered the Larboard
Port. At 12:00 and got one
Middle part light air from the
N.E. steering S. Latter part calm
True Sail in eight.

Lat. 2° 33' N. Long 28° 56' W.

Monday Jan. 6th

First part light air from the S. steering
South. Rained at School of Cornall
Wester at 2 o'clock A.M. Small downed.
Went 12:00 struck one. Landed him
up got him alongside and finished
cutting at 9 o'clock and set the watch.
Middle part light air from the N.E.
steering S. Latter part light variable
winds and calms.

Lat. 2° 11' N. Long 26° 48' W.

Tuesday Jan. 7th 1879.

First part light breeze from the
S. by the wind Port back
Fore sail in eight.
Middle part wind S. S. E.
Latter part calm.

Lat. 1° 55' N. Long 27° 24' W.

Wednesday Jan. 8th 1879

First part calm. Middle and Latter part
the same and cloudy. in observation
Picked out the alk fish.

Thursday Jan. 9th

First part light air from the S. on
Port back. Middle part wind S. S. W.
more calm on Starboard back. Lat. 2° 56' N. Long 27° 33' W.

Friday Jan. 10th

First part calm. Calm all day.
Engaged in general work about the
ships. Lat. 3° 13' N. Long 27° 41' W.

Saturday Jan. 11th

First part light variable winds & calms.
Put out a new boat on the Larboard
beam. Middle & latter part light air &
calms with rain squalls.
Lat. 3° 12' N. Long 27° 30' W.

Sunday Jan. 12th

First part calm. Light sail in eight.
Middle & latter part the same.
Lat. 3° 33' N. Long 27° 15' W.

Monday Jan. 13th

First part light air from the N.E.
steering S. Fore sail in eight.
Middle part light air from the
S.E. by the wind on Port back.
Latter part light breeze from the
E. S. E. steering S. by W.
Lat. 3° 40' N. Long 27° 19' W.
