

Sunday Feb 2nd 1879.

First part light breeze from the S.E. steering S.W. by W. Tiddle & latter part light breeze from the N.E. steering S.W. Lat. 29° S. Long $41^{\circ} 54'$ W.

Monday Feb 3rd

First part light breeze from the N.E. steering S.W. Tiddle & latter part light breeze from the N. with squalls of rain. Repaired the foremast. Lat. $30^{\circ} 50'$ S. Long $42^{\circ} 16'$ W.

Tuesday Feb 4th

First part fresh breeze from the N.W. and S. with squalls of rain steering S.W. Middle part light breeze from the N.W. latter part wind S.E. and light. The Steward, who has been incapable of doing his duty, but now in the fore-cabin and another called Antonio in Steward. Lat. $31^{\circ} 52'$ S. Long $44^{\circ} 22'$.

Wednesday Feb 5th

First part light wind from the S.E. steering by the wind on Port tack. Put back a new boat on main cranes and hauled the old one on the cranes. Middle part light breeze from the East steering S.S.W. latter part wind N.E. Raised a school of sperm whales at 7 o'clock P.M. and large whale going about S.E. Starboard boat struck first and showed faint boat struck and saved a small one.

Thursday Feb 6th 1879.

First part light breeze from the N.E. Got the whale alongside and finished cutting and deck clear up at 6 o'clock. Took in light sails and left off N.W. by N. commenced cutting up the whale. Middle part wind clear and commenced feeding. Latter part fresh breeze from the N.E. on Starboard tack. Lat $32^{\circ} 29'$ S. Long $45^{\circ} 15'$ W.

Friday Feb 7th

First part fresh breeze from the N. on Port tack. Finished feeding. Middle part strong breeze from the N.W. latter part blowing at gale from the N. Lat. $32^{\circ} 31'$ Long $44^{\circ} 35'$ W.

Saturday Feb 8th

First part blowing at moderate gale from the N. Tack on Port tack. Middle part wind moderate and hauled to the South. Latter part light breeze from the South. Employed in salting out milk provisions, and steering down it. Lat. $32^{\circ} 08'$ Long $45^{\circ} 50'$ W.

Sunday Feb 9th

First part fresh breeze from the N. on Port tack by the wind. Middle part calm latter part light breeze from the East steering S. Lat. $32^{\circ} 21'$ S. Long $45^{\circ} 21'$ W.
