Tuesday Feb 25th

Commenced with a gale from the N.E. bore to on Port tack. Middle and latter part blowing strong, with rain.

Wednesday Feb 26th

First part blowing fair from the N.E. but moderating towards dark. Middle & latter part light breeze from the N. with a heavy swell from the S.E.

Lat 40° 03' S.
Long 47° 54' W.

Thursday Feb 27th

First part light breeze from the N. withing to crosswind. One sail in sight to leeward. Middle part wind hauled to S.W. kept off North. Latter part strong breeze steering N. N.E.

Lat 38° 45' S.
Long 47° 34' W.

Friday Feb 28th

First part blowing a fresh breeze from the N. S. W. steering N.E. by N. One sail in sight. Middle and latter part withed N. steering N.E.

Lat 36° 26' S.
Long 44° 39' W.

Saturday March 1st

First part fresh breeze from the N.E. steering N. Middle & latter part light breeze from the N. steering N. East

Lat 34° 21' N.
Long 14° 02' W.

Sunday March 2nd

First part light air from the W. steering N. East. Raised a long gun whale at 1 o'clock. I. in. and lowered for him at 3 o'clock. Boat stuck about 5 o'clock. Towed him up and got him alongside of the ship. Made him fast and set the anchor and commenced to get ready for cutting. Middle & latter part light breeze from the N. cutting.

Lat 34° 22' S.
Long

Monday March 3rd

Light air from the N. cutting. Got the body in before sundown. Let the hooker lay along side. Started the masts & raised up sails. Middle & latter part sailing. Worked on to the beach and took in the junk, & the chain parties so that lost the case.

Lat 34° 04' S.
Long 43° 07' W.
