singing.

Long. $6^{\circ} 16' W$.

Thursday April 10th
First part five barge from the S.E.
steering N.E. half N. Middle part & latter
first barge steering N.E. by N.
Lat. $18^{\circ} 30' S$.
Long. $6^{\circ} 16' W$.

Friday April 11th
First part steering barge from the S.E.
steering N.E. Middle part the same
latter part steering N.E. by N.
Lat. $16^{\circ} S$.
Long. $5^{\circ} 58' W$.

Saturday April 12th
First part steering barge from the
S.E. and cloudy. Rpt. off N.W. by W.
half N. Found the Chathamian to be
lost, but don't know how much.
Middle part shortened sail &uffed
to on Port tack. New arrival at 1 P.M.
Latter part kept off N. N. E. Spotted the
Borne Handover by spoke, bar, and saw the
the Island of St. Helena at 9 o'clock
A.M.

Barge Claude At St. Helena.

Sunday April 13th
First part first barge. Came to an anchor
in St. Helena at 3 P.M. Found a fleet of British
whaleships here. Middle & latter part doing nothing.

Monday April 14th
Employed in cleaning ship & getting ready
to back out.

Tuesday April 15th
Employed in backing out, cooping, and
filling oil.

Wednesday April 16th
Employed in shipping oil on board
the Bark.

Thursday April 17th
Employed in setting up shrocks, and
packed ship.

Friday April 18th
Employed in setting up shrocks, and
gave one watch liberty.

Saturday 19th
Took water on board, and gave one watch
liberty.

Sunday 20th
Part of the men on shore on a run,
and the rest doing nothing.
