 First part fine breeze from the S. backed
 ship at dark. Middle & latter part
 wind light, calm.
 Lat $14^{\circ} 42' S.$
 Long 48° miles East.

Monday May 12th
 First part light fair from the S.E. on
 Port tack. Middle part the same. Latter
 part fine breeze. On Starboard tack.
 Lat $14^{\circ} 41' S.$
 Long 28° miles East.

Tuesday May 13th
 First part fine breeze from the S.E. on
 Starboard tack. Middle part the same.
 Latter part on Port tack.
 Lat $14^{\circ} 34' S.$
 Long $1^{\circ} 26'$ East.

Wednesday May 14th
 First part fine breeze from the S.E.
 backed ship at dark. Middle part
 the same. Latter part on Port tack.
 Lat $15^{\circ} 12' S.$
 Long $1^{\circ} 24'$ East.

Thursday May 15th
 First part fresh breeze from the S.E.
 on Port tack. Out to sea but not far S.
 breeze. Middle part strong breeze. Latter
 part on Starboard tack.

Lat $16^{\circ} 11' S.$
 Long $1^{\circ} 14'$ East.

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Friday May 16th
 First part strong breeze from the S.E.
 on Starboard tack. The same throughout
 the day.
 Lat $15^{\circ} 21' S.$
 Long $2^{\circ} 13'$ East.

Saturday May 17th
 Fresh trade on Starboard tack. all day
 employed in general work about the ship.
 Lat $14^{\circ} 45' S.$
 Long $3^{\circ} 20'$ East.

Sunday May 18th
 First part fresh trade, and the same
 all day. On Starboard tack.
 Lat $14^{\circ} 26' S.$
 Long $4^{\circ} 47'$ East.

Monday May 19th
 First part fresh trade on Starboard tack
 until dark, when we rounded head
 land. the same, latter part on Starboard
 tack.
 Lat $14^{\circ} 40' S.$ Long $5^{\circ} 13'$ East.

Tuesday May 20th
 First part fresh breeze on Starboard tack.
 Middle part on Port tack. Latter part on Starboard
 tack.
 Lat $14^{\circ} 56' S.$
 Long $5^{\circ} 22'$ East.
