

Bark *Clavis* Off the Coast of Africa 1879.Thursday May 29th

First part with *Zepp* on Starboard tack, were anchored at dark. Middle & latter part on Port tack under short sail employed in stowing down rig.
Lat. $16^{\circ} 21' S$.
Long $6^{\circ} 21' E$.

Friday May 30th

First part light trades, kept off N.E. were sailed to on Starboard tack at dark. Financed stowing down. Middle part laid aback. Latter part on Starboard tack.
Lat. $15^{\circ} 55' S$.
Long $7^{\circ} 7' East$.

Saturday May 31st

First part fresh trades, by the wind on Starboard tack, were anchored at dark. Middle and latter part cloudy got in Longitude.
Lat. $16^{\circ} 16' S$.

Sunday June 1st

First part fine breeze on Port tack. Middle part the same. Latter part under light on Starboard tack.
Lat. $16^{\circ} 32' S$.
Long $5^{\circ} 52' E$.

Monday June 2nd

First part light trades on Starboard tack. Saw a Whale in sight to leeward. Latter part the same, latter part on Port tack.
Lat. $16^{\circ} 28' S$.

Bark *Clavis* Off the Coast of Africa 1879Tuesday June 3rd

First part light trades on Port tack with fair head in sight. Middle part the same. Latter part on Starboard tack.
Lat. $16^{\circ} 42' S$.
Long $6^{\circ} 36' E$.

Wednesday June 4th

First part light trades on Starboard tack. Middle part the same. Latter part on Port tack.
Lat. $16^{\circ} 47' S$.
Long $7^{\circ} 03' E$.

Thursday June 5th

First part fresh trades, got Port tack. Spike Bark Gay Head, coming. Employed in stowing down rig, provisions. Middle part on Port tack. Latter part speck ship, again.
Lat. $17^{\circ} 11' S$.
Long $6^{\circ} 58' E$.

Friday June 6th

First part fresh trades on Starboard tack. Middle part & latter on Port tack. Storm surge. Employed in repairing foretop sail.
Lat. $17^{\circ} 41' S$.
Long $6^{\circ} E$.
