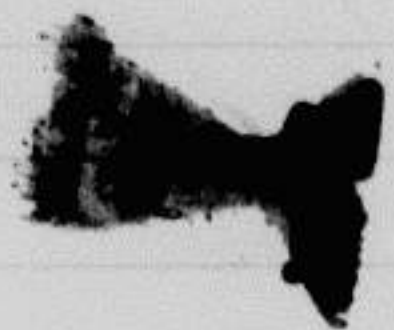


Bark *Clance* Off the Coast of Africa 1879Tuesday July 29th

First part light trader on Port tack
 Raised a fine Sperm Whale at 5 o'clock
 A.M. and lowered but did not have
 twilight enough to see him again
 Middle part on Starboard tack, latter
 part on Port.

Lat. $16^{\circ} 59' S.$
 Long $5^{\circ} 14' East$

Wednesday July 30th

First part light trader, about off N.W. then
 N.E. Luffed to the wind on Starboard.
 tack. Last side. Middle part fresh breeze.
 Latter part strong trader

Lat. $16^{\circ} 41'$
 Long $6^{\circ} 22'$

Thursday July 31st

First part strong trader on Starboard
 tack. Middle part on Port tack
 Latter part kept off N.E.

Lat. $16^{\circ} 27'$
 Long $5^{\circ} 44' East$

Friday August 1st

First part strong trader, on Starboard
 tack. Middle part more moderate on
 Port tack. Latter part wind light, on
 Starboard tack

Lat. $16^{\circ} 15' S.$
 Long $5^{\circ} 43' E.$

Bark *Clance* Off the Coast of Africa 1879.Saturday August 2nd

First part light trader on Starboard tack
 Middle & latter part light breeze from the N.
 & S.W.

Lat. $16^{\circ} 20'$
 Long

Sunday August 3rd

First part light breeze from the N. on
 the Starboard tack. Middle part the same
 Latter part more S.W.

Lat. $16^{\circ} 30' S.$
 Long $6^{\circ} 22' E.$

Monday August 4th

First part light breeze from the S. on Starboard
 tack to the wind. Middle part more around
 Latter part on Port tack.

Lat. $16^{\circ} 40'$
 Long $6^{\circ} 08'$

Tuesday Aug. 5th

First part light breeze from the S. steering
 N. by N. Middle part on Starboard tack
 light breeze. Latter part kept off N.E.
 Employed in repairing main-mast.

Wednesday Aug 6th

First part light trader, steering N.E. in
 fore on Starboard tack at dusk
 Latter part kept off N.E. busy in observation.
