Monday Aug 18th

First part light breeze from the S. Middle and latter part the same.

Lat. 6° 03' S.

Long 6° 15' E.

Tuesday Aug 19th

First part light breeze from the S. Middle & latter part wind S.S.W.

Lat. 6° 09'

Long 7° 33'

Wednesday Aug 20th

First part light breeze from the S.S.W. Middle & latter part the same. On the Starboard tack.

Lat. 6° 36' S.

Long 8° 32' E.

Thursday Aug 21st

First part light breeze from the S.S.W. The same throughout the day, On S tack.

Lat. 7° S.

Long 9° 51' E.

Friday Aug 22nd

First part light wind from the S.E. on Starboard tack. Middle & latter part light breeze & calm.

Lat. 6° 38' S.

Long 10° 29' East.

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Saturday Aug 23rd

First part light air from the S. steering E.S.E. Middle part raised fire armed and found our ammunition to be out of the ordered make, calm. Latter part light air from the South kept off along the coast.

Lat. 6° 28' S.

Sunday Aug 24th

First part light fair from the S. steering S. got the anchors off the son. Middle part & latter the same.

Monday Aug 25th

First part came to an anchor in "Kabinda" and stowed sails. Middle part & latter getting ready to get under.

Tuesday Aug 26th

Employed in getting off water and stowing it away.

Wednesday Aug 27th

Employed in getting water, and one watch on liberty.

Thursday Aug 28th

Employed in getting water, and one watch on liberty.

Friday Aug 29th

First part light air off the land got under way and stood off by the girdle. Middle and latter part light breeze, trying to make of shore.
